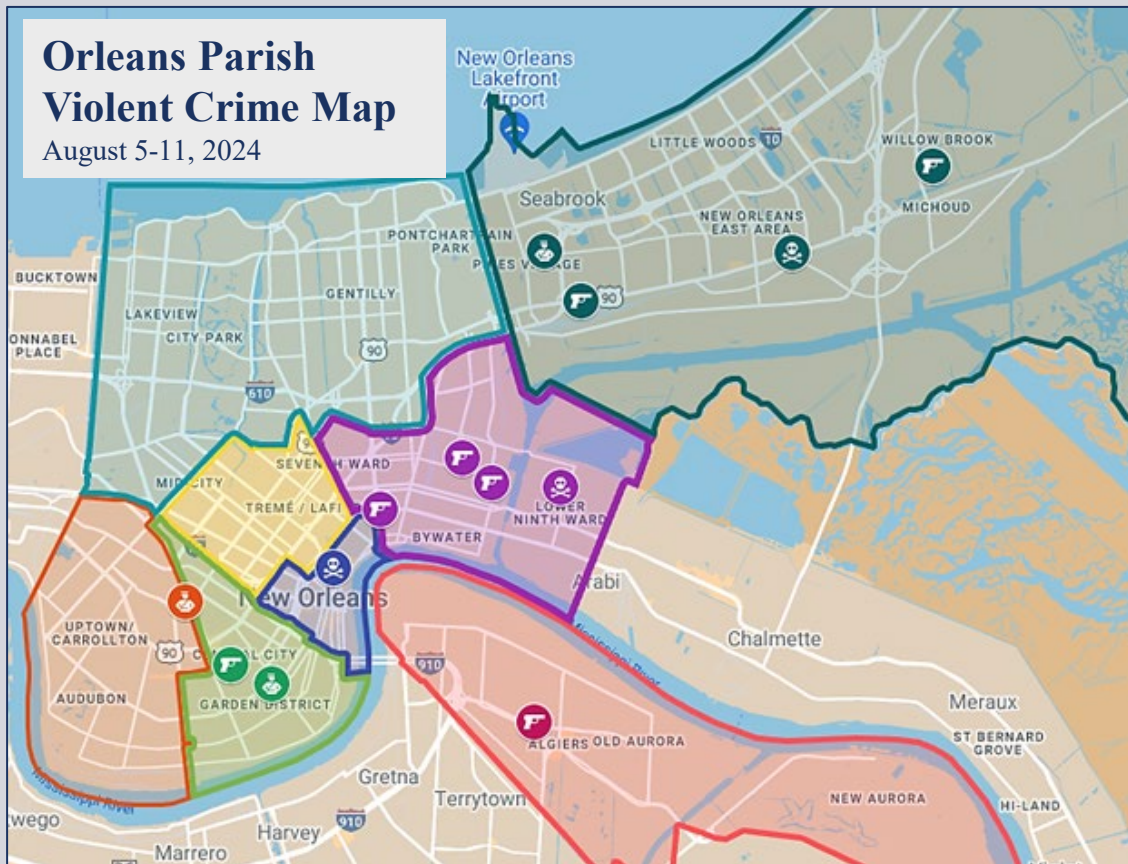


There were 13 major violent incidents last week – 3 homicides, 7 nonfatal shootings, and 3 armed robberies. No carjacking incidents were reported.

There were no major violent incidents in the 1st District or 3rd District last week.

Orleans Parish Violent Crime Map

Homicide Victims: 96

- 38% since 2023 (155 victims)
- 48% since 2022 (183 victims)
- 24% since 2021 (126 victims)
- 8% since 2020 (104 victims)
- +22% since 2019 (79 victims)

Nonfatal Shooting Incidents: 150

- 39% since 2023 (247 incidents)
- 48% since 2022 (287 incidents)
- 55% since 2021 (332 incidents)
- 28% since 2020 (208 incidents)
- +2% since 2019 (147 incidents)

Carjacking Incidents: 60

- 41% since 2023 (102 incidents)
- 68% since 2022 (188 incidents)
- 66% since 2021 (175 incidents)
- 39% since 2020 (98 incidents)
- 5% since 2019 (63 incidents)

Armed Robbery Incidents: 157

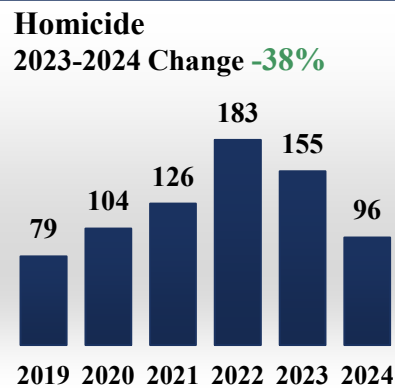
- 37% since 2023 (251 incidents)
- 56% since 2022 (354 incidents)
- 35% since 2021 (242 incidents)
- 26% since 2020 (211 incidents)
- 42% since 2019 (270 incidents)



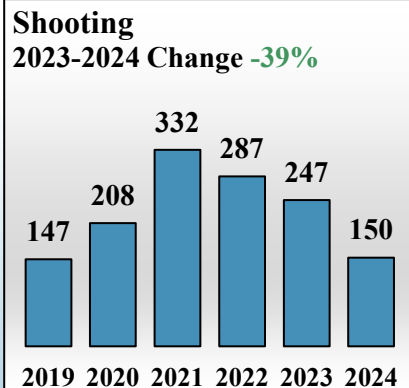

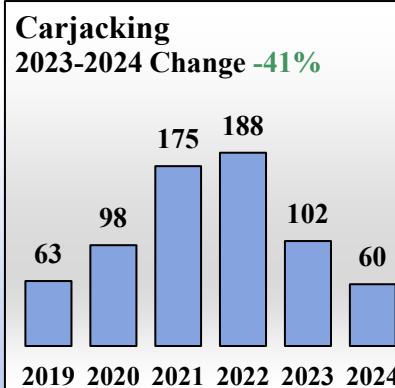

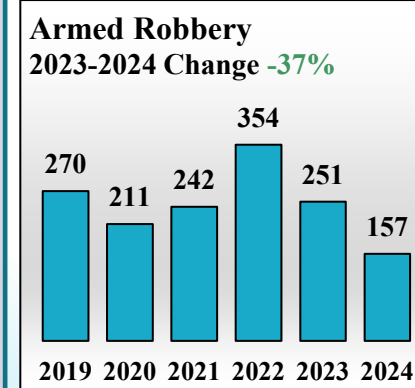

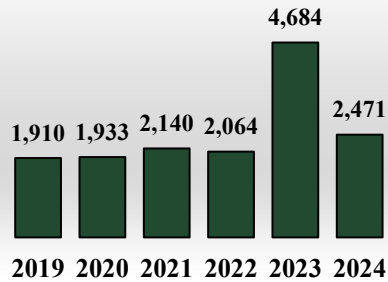

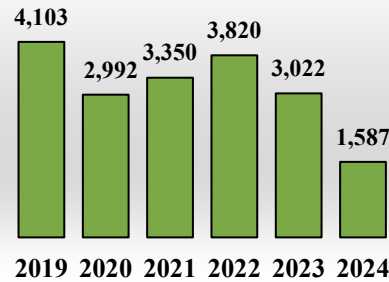

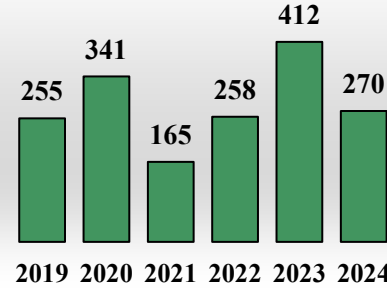

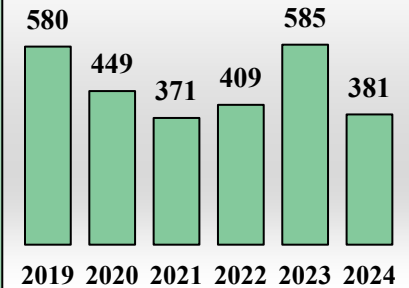

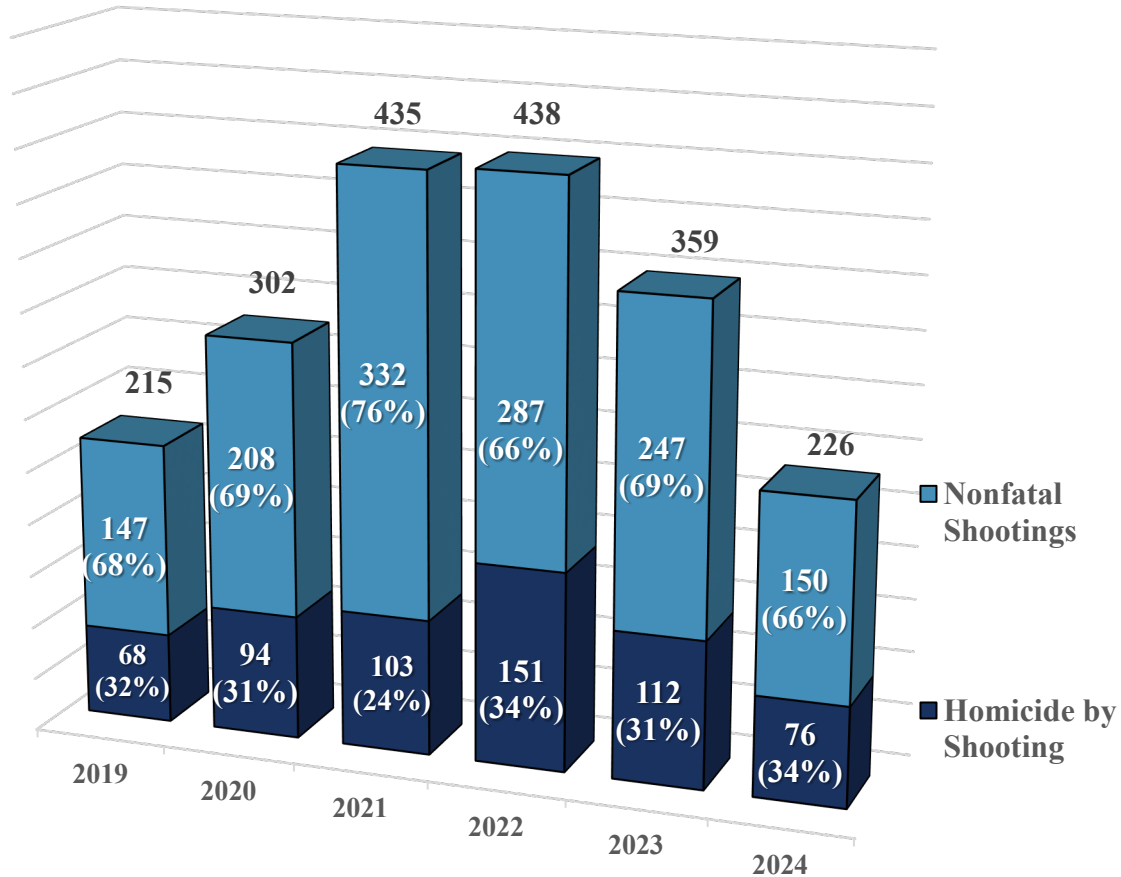

2023-2024 CHANGE: -37%

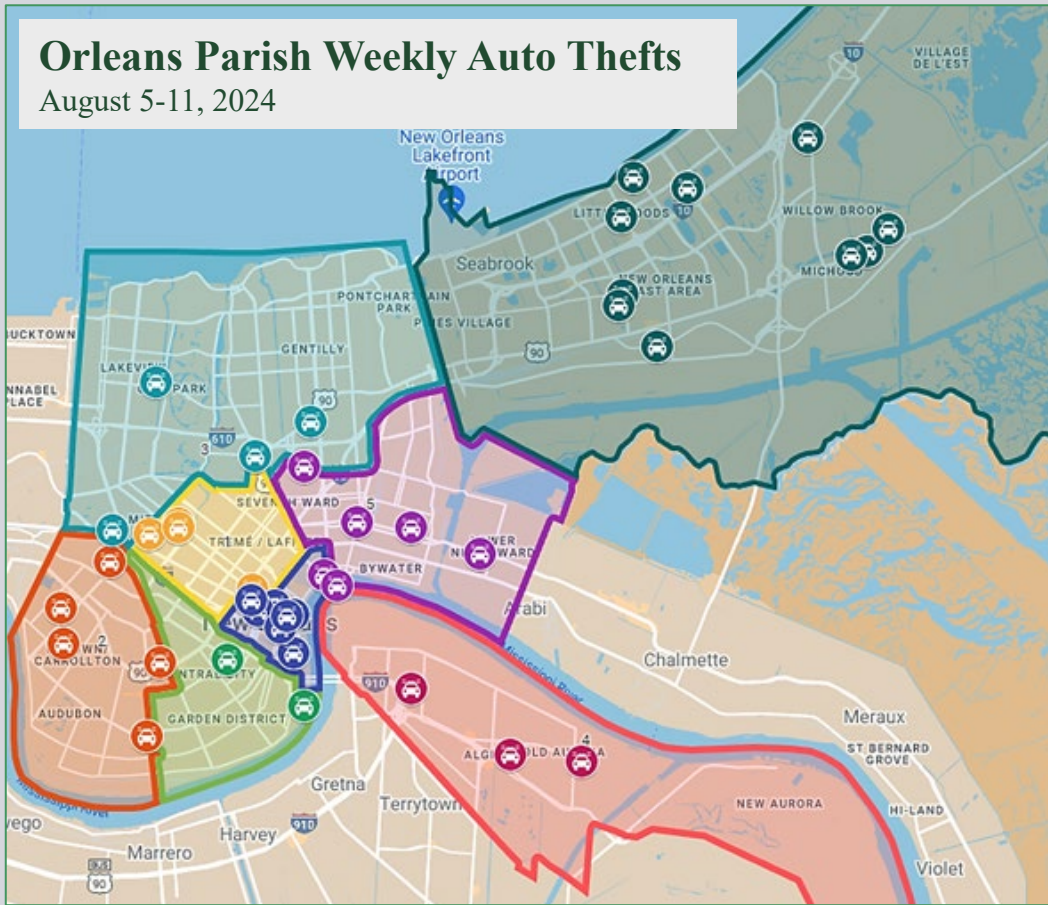

August 5-11, 2024



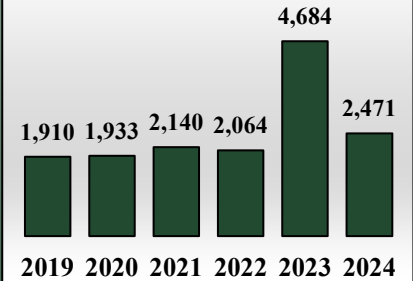
Between August 5-11, 2024, there were 42 reported auto thefts across Orleans Parish

2023-2024 Change **-47%**



Year	Reported Auto Theft	2024 Change
2024	2,471	---
2023	4,684	-47%
2022	2,064	+20%
2021	2,140	+15%
2020	1,933	+28%
2019	1,910	+29%

In 2024, there has been an average of 11 stolen vehicles per day.

This is a large improvement compared with 2023, when auto theft was occurring at a rate of 21 stolen vehicles per day.
