



ORLEANS PARISH CRIME TRENDS

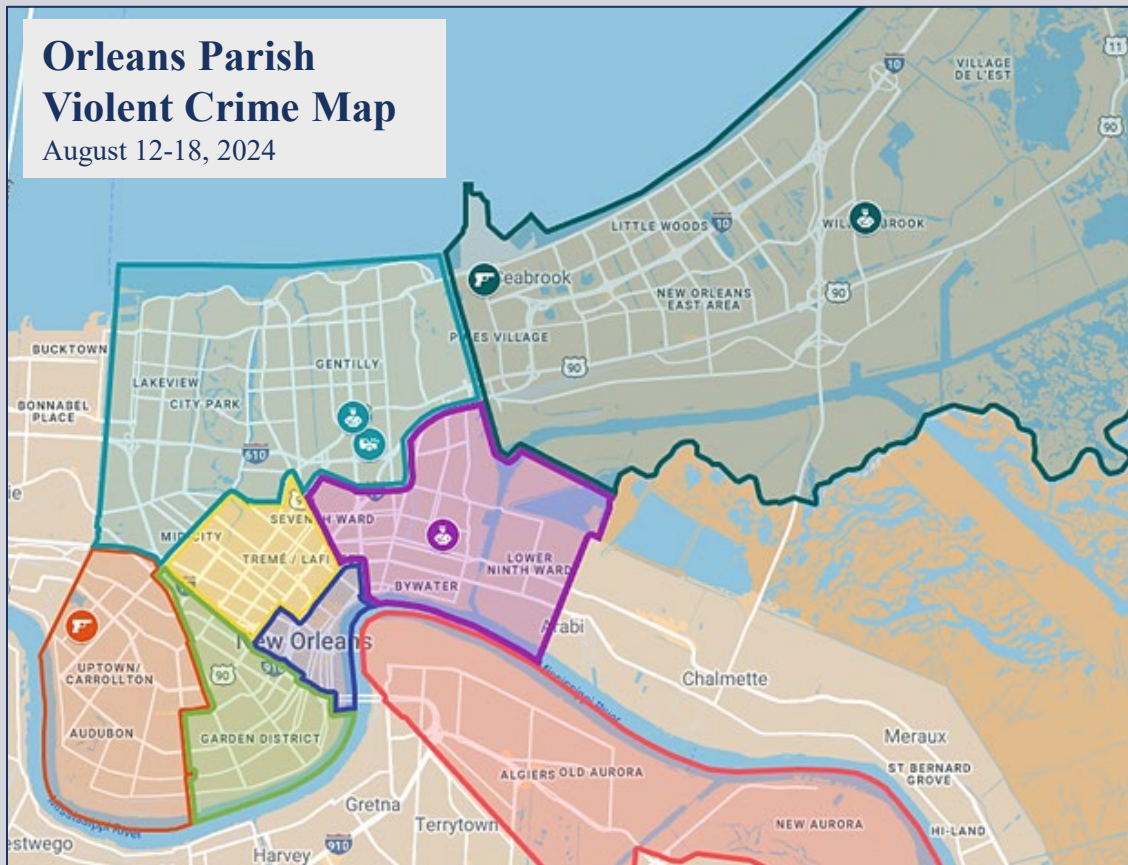
AS OF AUGUST 18, 2019-2024

For the first time since December of 2023, there were no reported homicides in the past week. The six major violent incident reports included 2 shootings, 1 carjacking, and 3 armed robberies.

There were no major violent incidents last week in the **1st District, 4th District, 6th District, or 8th District.**

Homicide Victims: 96

- 40% since 2023 (160 victims)
- 48% since 2022 (186 victims)
- 27% since 2021 (132 victims)
- 9% since 2020 (105 victims)
- +20% since 2019 (80 victims)

Nonfatal Shooting Incidents: 152

- 41% since 2023 (258 incidents)
- 48% since 2022 (295 incidents)
- 55% since 2021 (341 incidents)
- 30% since 2020 (218 incidents)
- 0% since 2019 (152 incidents)

Carjacking Incidents: 60

- 43% since 2023 (106 incidents)
- 68% since 2022 (188 incidents)
- 66% since 2021 (176 incidents)
- 40% since 2020 (100 incidents)
- 5% since 2019 (63 incidents)

Armed Robbery Incidents: 160

- 37% since 2023 (254 incidents)
- 56% since 2022 (364 incidents)
- 36% since 2021 (250 incidents)
- 27% since 2020 (220 incidents)
- 44% since 2019 (286 incidents)



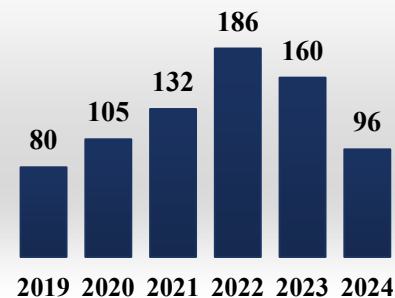

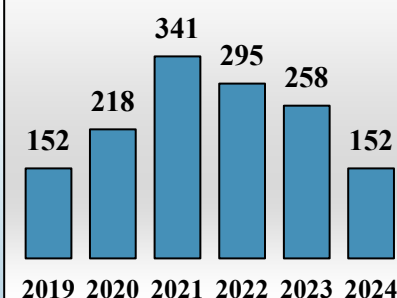

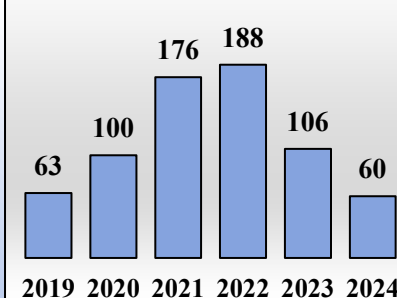

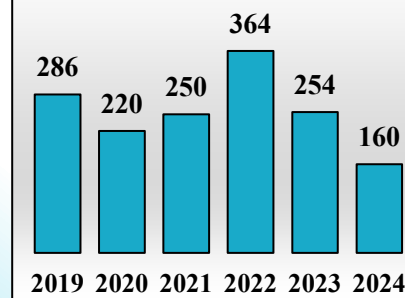

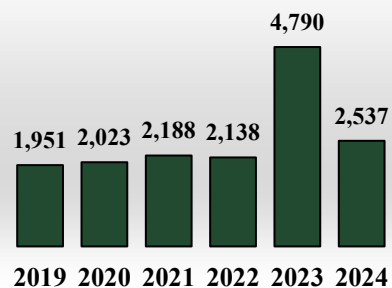

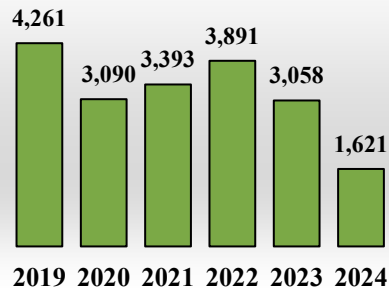

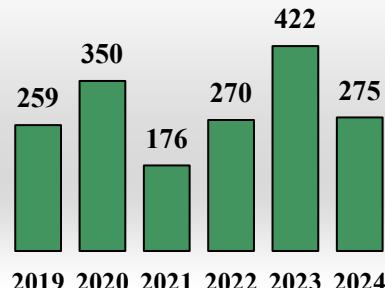

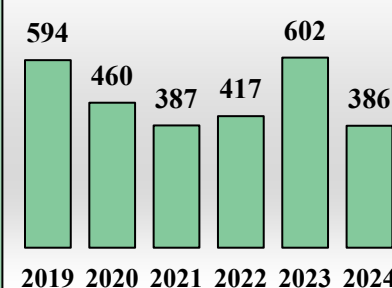

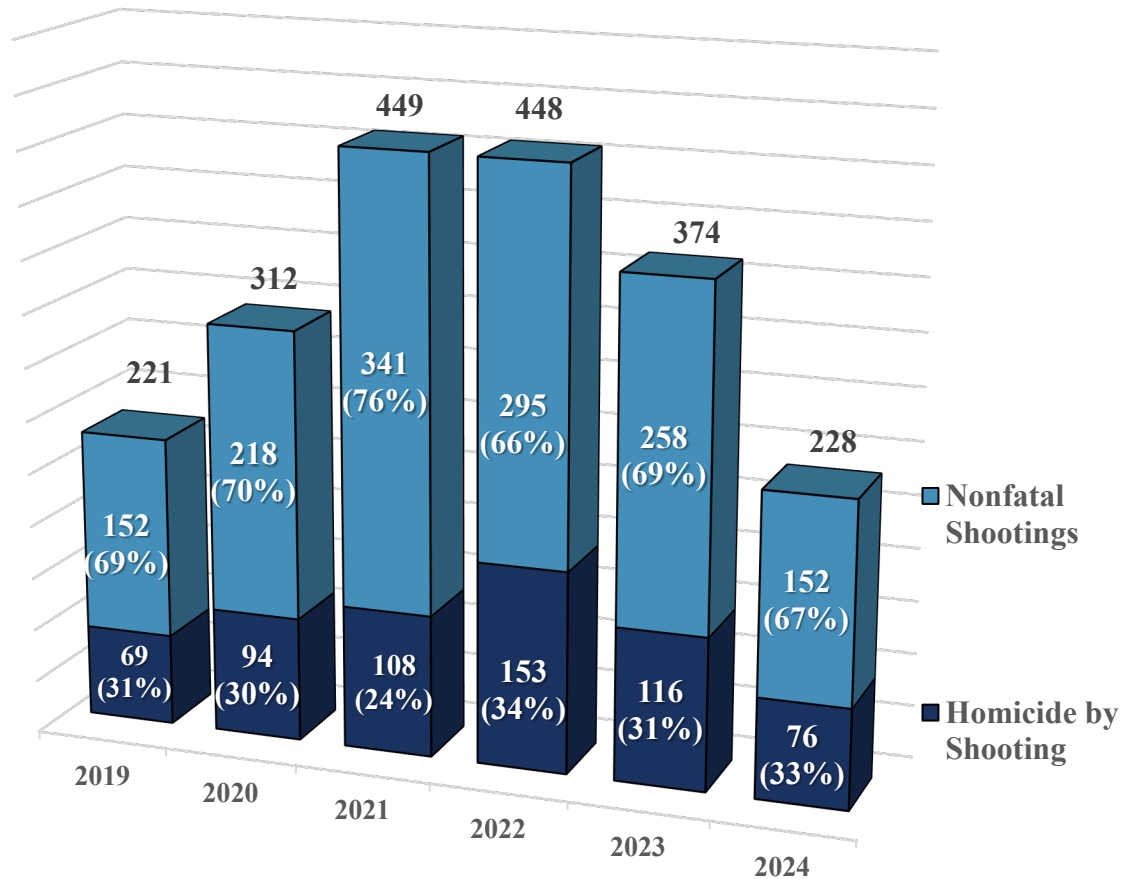

2023-2024 CHANGE: -39%

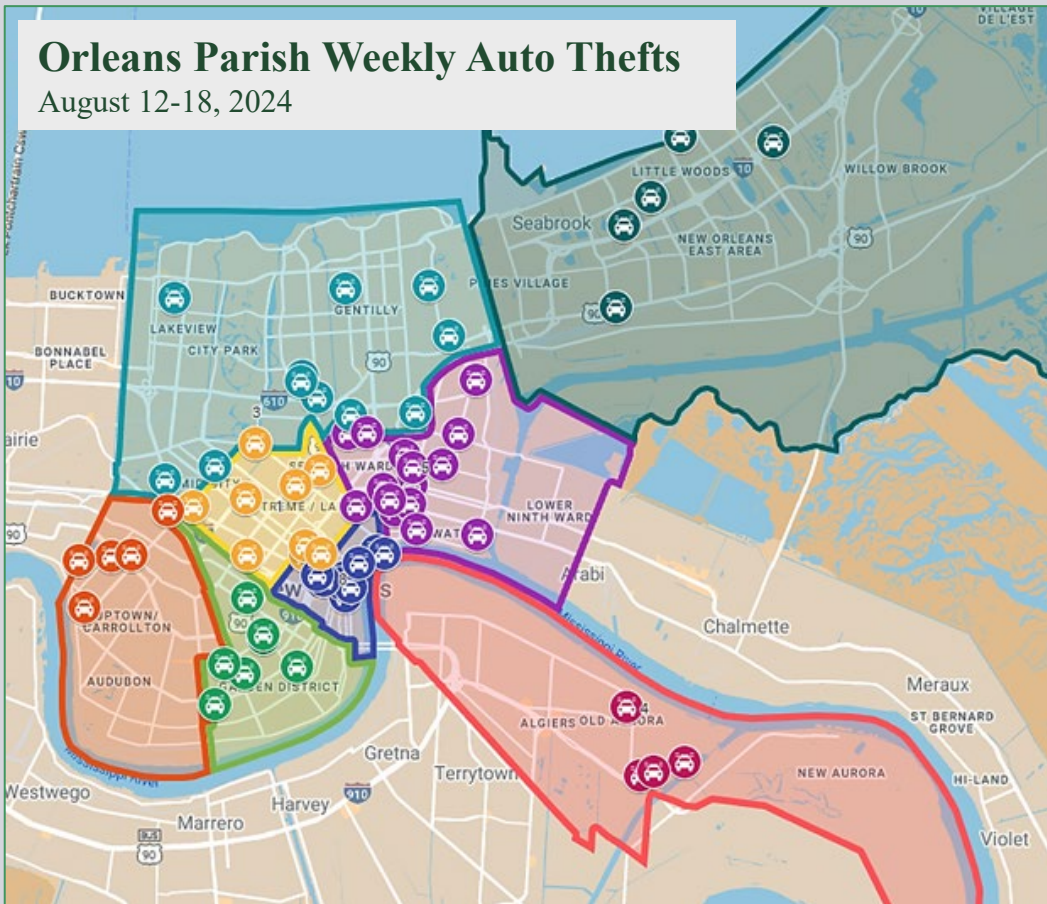

August 12-18, 2024



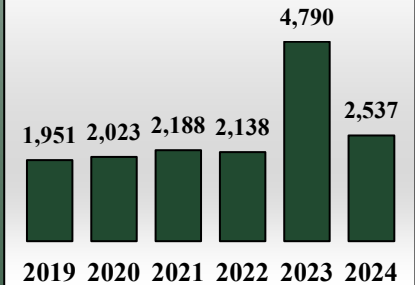
Between August 12-18, 2024, there were 66 reported auto thefts across Orleans Parish

- 6th District: 7 auto thefts**
- 7th District: 5 auto thefts**
- 8th District: 10 auto thefts**

Auto Theft

2023-2024 Change **-47%**



Year	Reported Auto Theft	2024 Change
2024	2,537	---
2023	4,790	-47%
2022	2,138	+19%
2021	2,188	+16%
2020	2,023	+25%
2019	1,951	+30%

In 2024, there has been an average of 11 stolen vehicles per day.

This is a large improvement compared with 2023, when auto theft was occurring at a rate of 21 stolen vehicles per day.
