The 1st District had the largest declines in **homicide (-80%)** and **nonfatal shooting (-71%)** of any NOPD District YTD from 2023 to 2024.

In 2023, the 1st District had the third highest number of all NOPD Districts of both **homicide** and **nonfatal shooting**. By 2024, the 1st District improved to ranking the lowest of all 8 Districts on **homicide** and 7 of 8 Districts on **nonfatal shooting**.

Although the 1st District had an increase **(+22%)** in **carjacking** between 2023-2024, there has been a substantial **(-67%)** decline in 1st District **carjacking** since 2022.

1st District **armed robbery** is at a six-year low YTD in 2024 and has declined **-79%** since reaching a YTD high of 63 in 2022. In 2024, the 1st District had the fewest YTD **armed robberies** citywide.

At 11 **homicides** YTD in 2024 the 2nd District is tied with the 8th District, ranked 4 of the 8 NOPD Districts on **homicide** YTD in 2024.

2nd District **nonfatal shooting** incidents increased from 7 YTD in 2023 to 9 YTD in 2024. However, the 2nd District has had fewer **nonfatal shooting** incidents than any other NOPD District YTD in 2024.

2nd District **carjacking** reached a YTD high of 20 in 2022 and has since declined **-55%**. The 2nd District increased from 5 to 9 **carjackings** YTD 2023 and 2024.

The 18 2nd District **armed robbery** incidents are the District's fewest across the past six years. However, the 2nd District ranks fourth of 8 NOPD Districts in **armed robbery**.



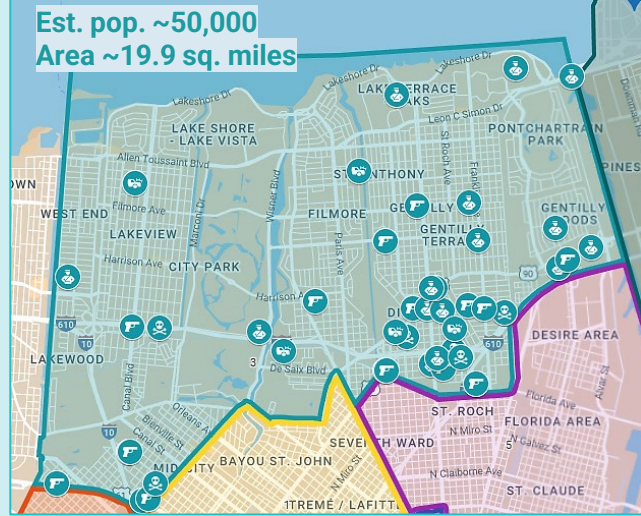

The 3rd District had the second-largest decline in **homicide (-59%)**, dropping from 17 YTD in 2023 to 7 YTD in 2024.

3rd District **nonfatal shooting** reached a YTD high of 41 in 2022 and has since declined **-61%**. At 16 **nonfatal shootings** YTD in 2024, the 3rd District declined **-27%** since YTD in 2023.

The 3rd District had the largest reduction (**-79%**) in YTD **carjacking** from 2023 to 2024. Since reaching a YTD high of 37 **carjackings** in 2021, the 3rd District has declined **-84%**.

3rd District **armed robbery** has declined **-72%** since YTD 2022 and **-29%** since YTD 2024. At 17 YTD **armed robberies**, the 3rd District ranked fifth of the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024.



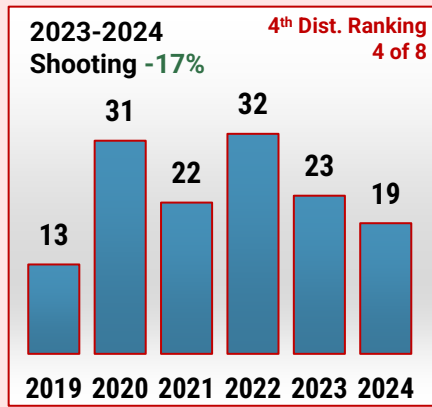
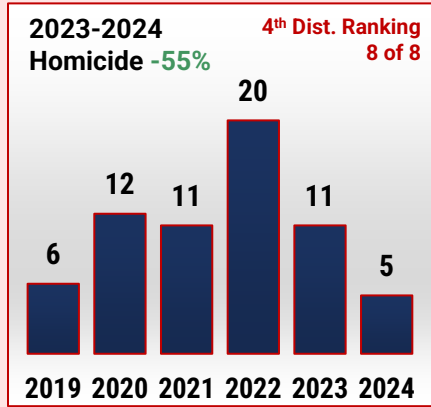
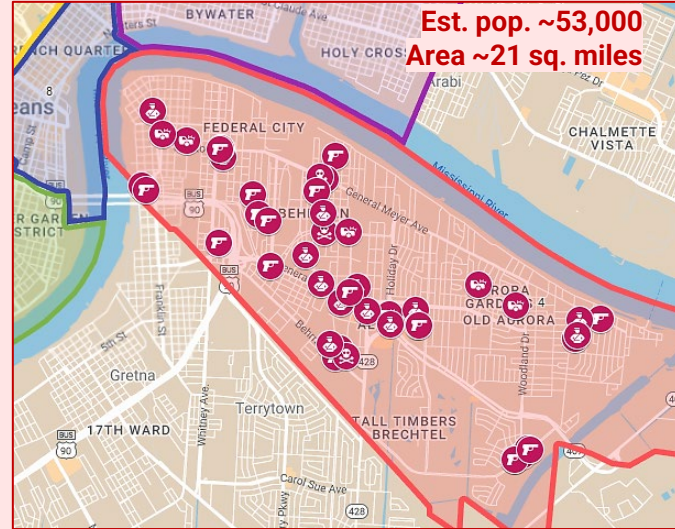

YTD, all four categories of major violent crime decreased in the 4th District compared to both 2022 and 2023.

At 5 **homicides** YTD in 2024, the 4th District has the lowest number of YTD **homicide** of the 8 NOPD Districts. 4th District **homicide** declined **-75%** since YTD in 2022 and **-55%** since YTD in 2023.



4th District YTD **nonfatal shooting** declined **-41%** since 2022 and **-17%** since 2023. At 19 incidents YTD in 2024, the 4th District ranked fourth of the 8 NOPD Districts in **nonfatal shooting**.

Despite YTD declines in both **homicide (-38%)** and **nonfatal shooting (-33%)**, the 5th District ranked first of the 8 NOPD Districts for having the highest number of YTD incidents in all four categories of major violent crime.

The 5th and 7th Districts each had 26 YTD **homicides** in 2024.

Nonfatal shooting declined **-48%** in the 5th District since reaching a YTD high of 91 in 2021.

5th District **carjacking** and **armed robbery** had no change YTD 2023 to 2024.

Since 2022, 5th District **carjacking** declined **-58%**, from 38 to 16 incidents YTD in 2023 and 2024.

Since 2022, 5th District **armed robbery** declined **-40%**, from 62 to 37 YTD in 2023 and 2024.



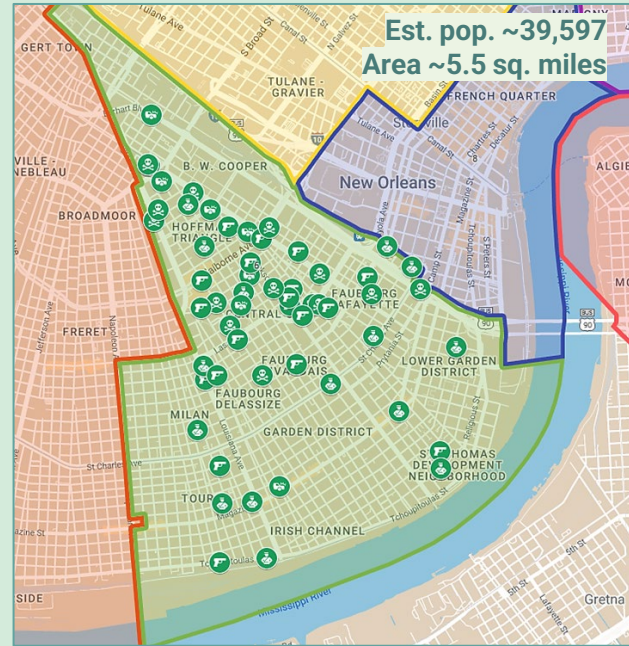

6th District **homicide** declined **-40%** YTD from 2022 to 2024 and **-29%** YTD from 2023 to 2024.

Nonfatal shooting in the 6th District has declined **-50%** since reaching a YTD high of 44 in 2021.

At 15 **homicides** and 22 **nonfatal shootings** YTD, the 6th District ranked third highest of the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024.

Carjacking in the 6th District declined **-82%** since reaching a YTD high of 28 in 2022. Since 2023, **carjacking** declined **-55%** in the 6th District, which ranked seventh of the 8 NOPD Districts YTD in 2024.

Armed robbery in the 6th District was at a six-year low of 15 YTD in 2024. Since 2023, 6th District **armed robbery** declined **-55%** YTD.



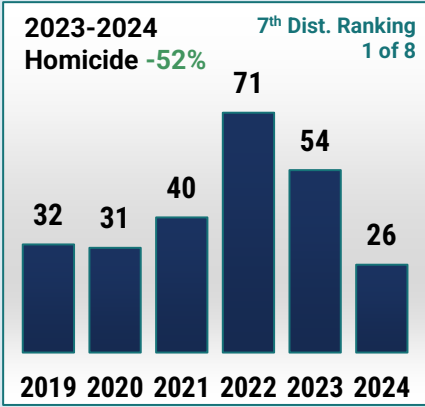
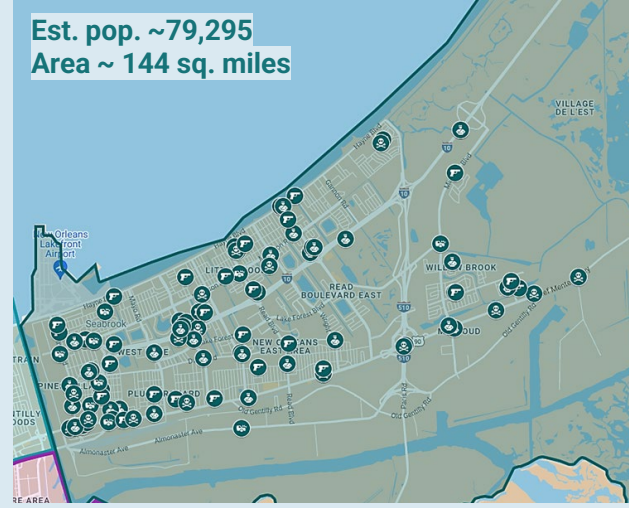

The 7th District reached a six-year low in all four major violent crime categories YTD in 2024.

While still ranked first of 8 NOPD Districts for having the highest number of YTD **homicides**, the 7th District declined **-52%** since 2023 and **-63%** since 2022.

Nonfatal shooting declined **-60%** since reaching a YTD high of 97 incidents in 2021. Since 2023, 7th District **nonfatal shooting** declined **(-55%)** to six-year low of 39 YTD incidents in 2024.

Carjacking in the 7th District has declined substantially **(-84%)** since reaching a YTD high of 76 incidents in 2022.

Armed robbery in the 7th District declined **-51%** in 2024 compared YTD to 2023. The 7th District ranked third of the 8 NOPD Districts YTD in 2024 for **armed robbery**.



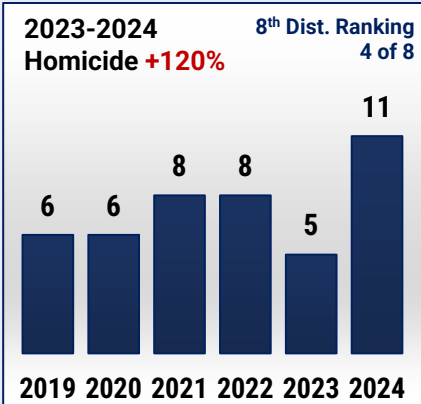
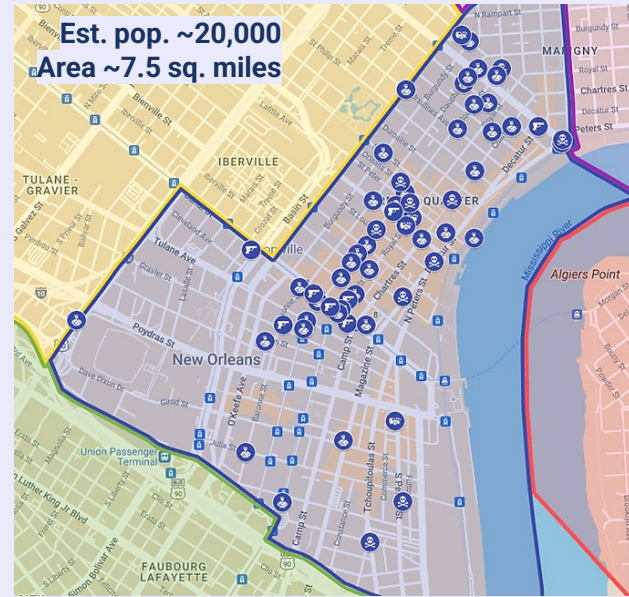

8th District **homicide** was at a six-year high YTD in 2024. At 11 **homicides** YTD, the 8th District is tied with the 2nd District, ranked fourth of the 8 NOPD Districts.

Nonfatal shooting in the 8th District has declined **-62%** since reaching a YTD high of 29 in 2021. 8th District **nonfatal shooting** declined **-48%** from YTD in 2023 to 2024.

Carjacking has declined **-67%** YTD since 2022 and **-20%** since 2023. The 8th District is ranked eighth of the 8 NOPD Districts for having the fewest **carjackings** YTD in 2024.

8th District **armed robbery** is **-38%** lower YTD in 2024 compared with 2022. However, at 36 incidents YTD, the 8th District is ranked second on the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024 YTD **armed robbery**.

Citywide, homicide has declined **-42%** since 2023 and **-52%** since 2022.

The **1st District** has shown the largest **(-80%)** reduction, from 25 YTD in 2023, to 5 YTD in 2024. Other notable declines since 2023 include the **3rd District (-59%)**, **4th District (-55%)**, and the **7th District (-52%)**.

The **7th District** had the largest raw number decline, from 54 YTD in 2023 to 26 YTD in 2024.

The **2nd District** increased **+38%** from 8 homicides YTD in 2023 to 11 YTD in 2024.

The **+120%** increase in **8th District** homicide reflects an increase from 5 YTD in 2023 to 11 YTD in 2024.

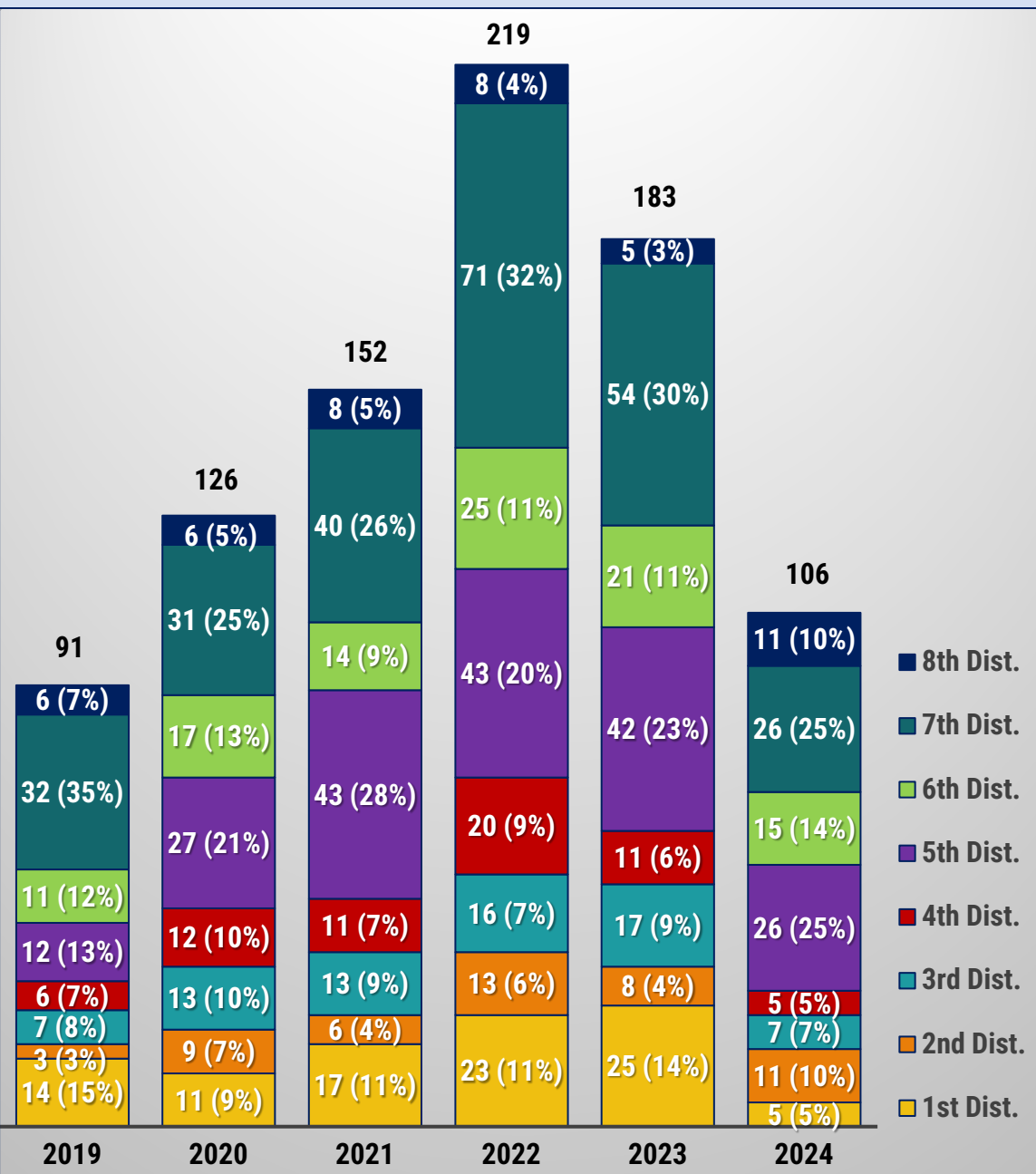

Since reaching a YTD high of 376 in 2021, citywide shooting incidents declined - **54%** since 2021, **-51%** since 2022, and **-42%** since 2023.

The **1st District** has shown the largest (**-71%**) reduction in shooting, from 35 YTD in 2023, to 10 YTD in 2024. The **1st District** also had the largest reduction in homicide.

The **7th District** showed a notable (**-55%**) decline, with 47 fewer shooting incidents reported YTD in 2024 than YTD in 2023.

The **2nd District** was the only NOPD District to report more shootings YTD in 2024 (9) than YTD in 2023 (7). However, the **2nd District** has reported the fewest shootings of any NOPD District YTD in 2024.

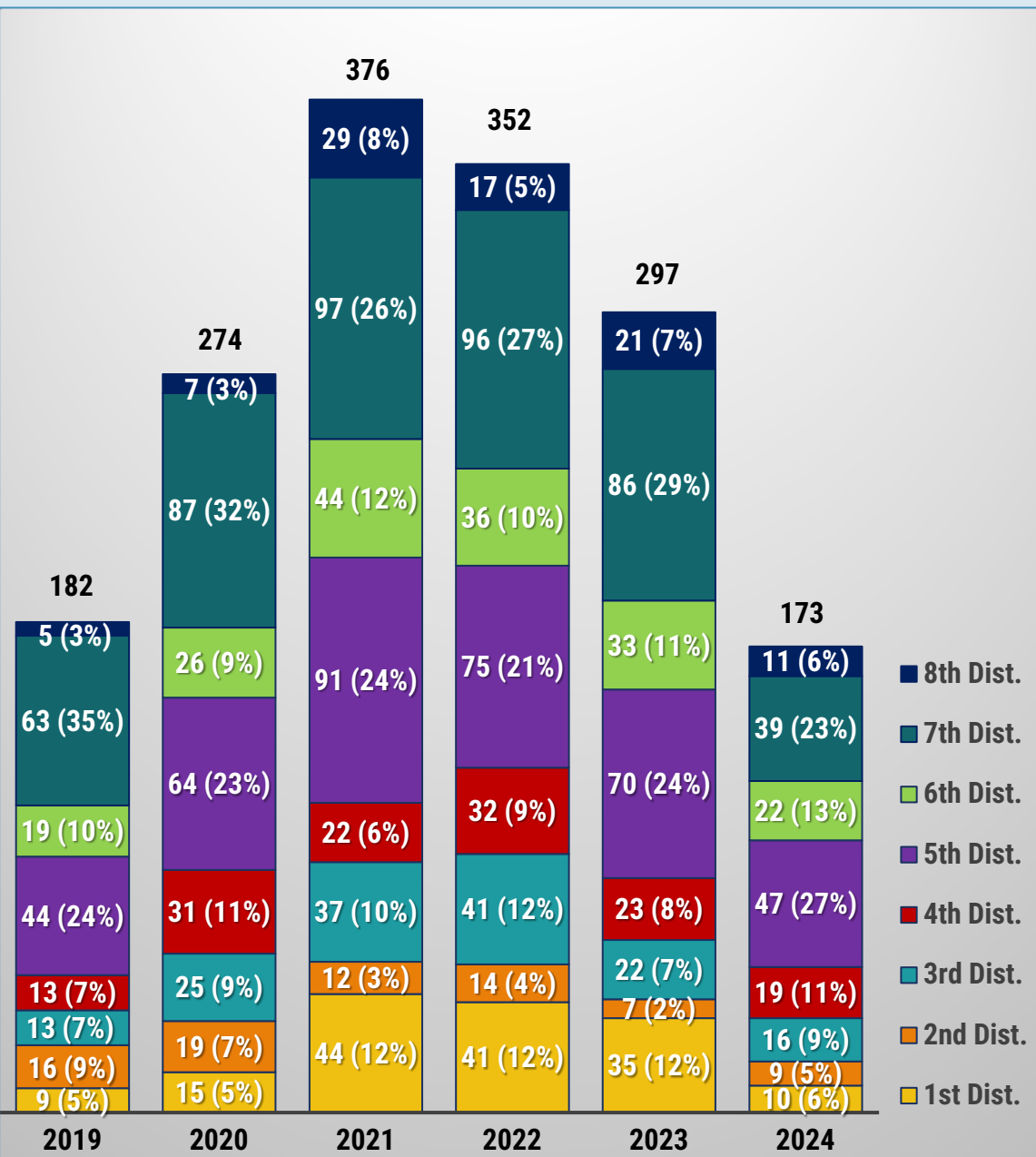

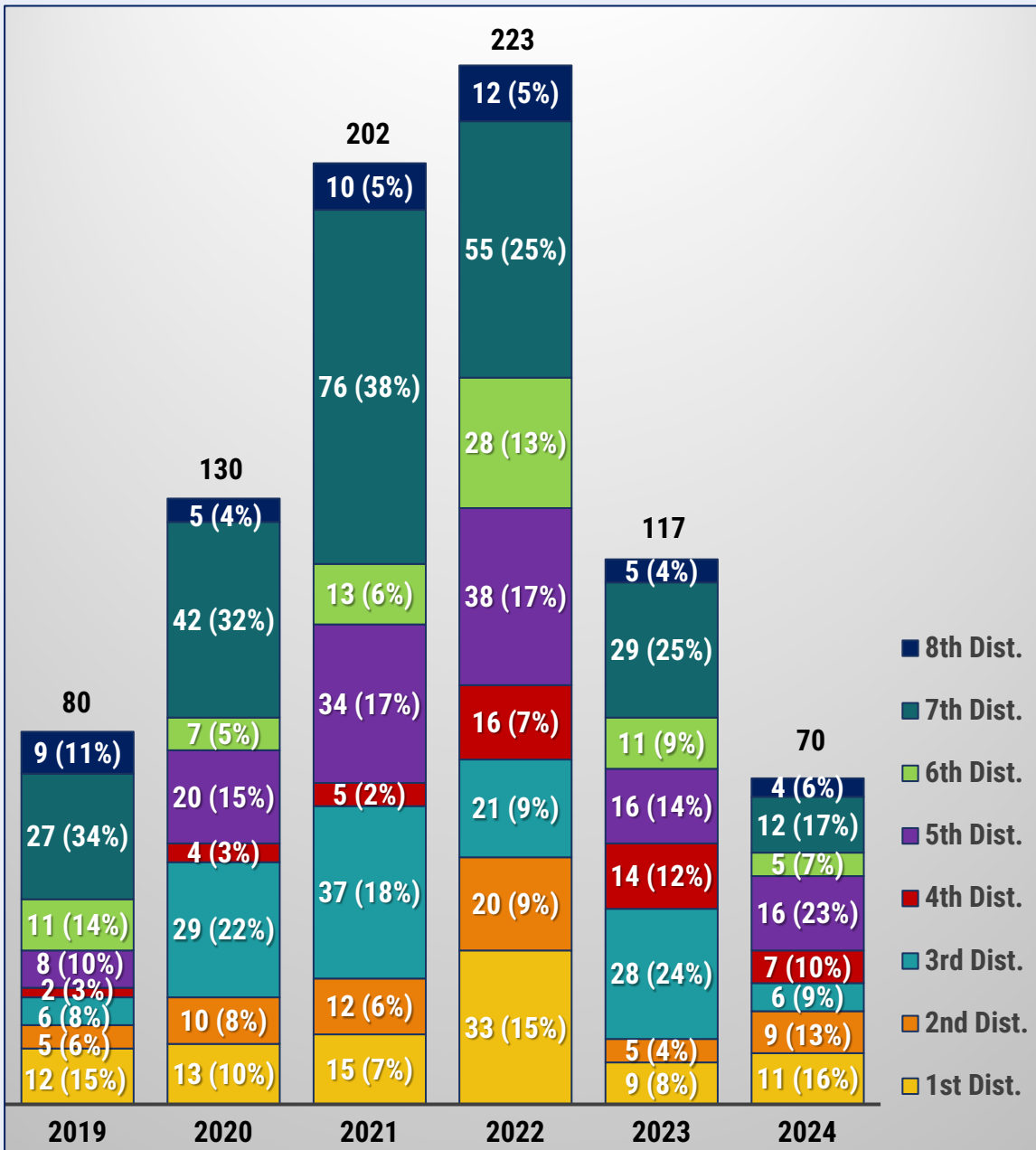

Citywide carjacking incidents reached a YTD high of 223 in 2022. At 70 YTD in 2024, carjacking has declined **-40%** since 2023 and **-69%** since 2022.

The **3rd District** showed the largest carjacking decline (**-79%**), from 28 YTD in 2023 to 6 YTD in 2024.

Several other districts showed notable decline in carjacking, including the **7th District** (**-59%**), **6th District** (**-55%**), and **4th District** (**-50%**).

The **2nd District** increased **+80%** from 5 YTD in 2023 to 9 YTD in 2024. The **1st District** increased **+22%** from 9 YTD in 2023 to 11 YTD in 2024.

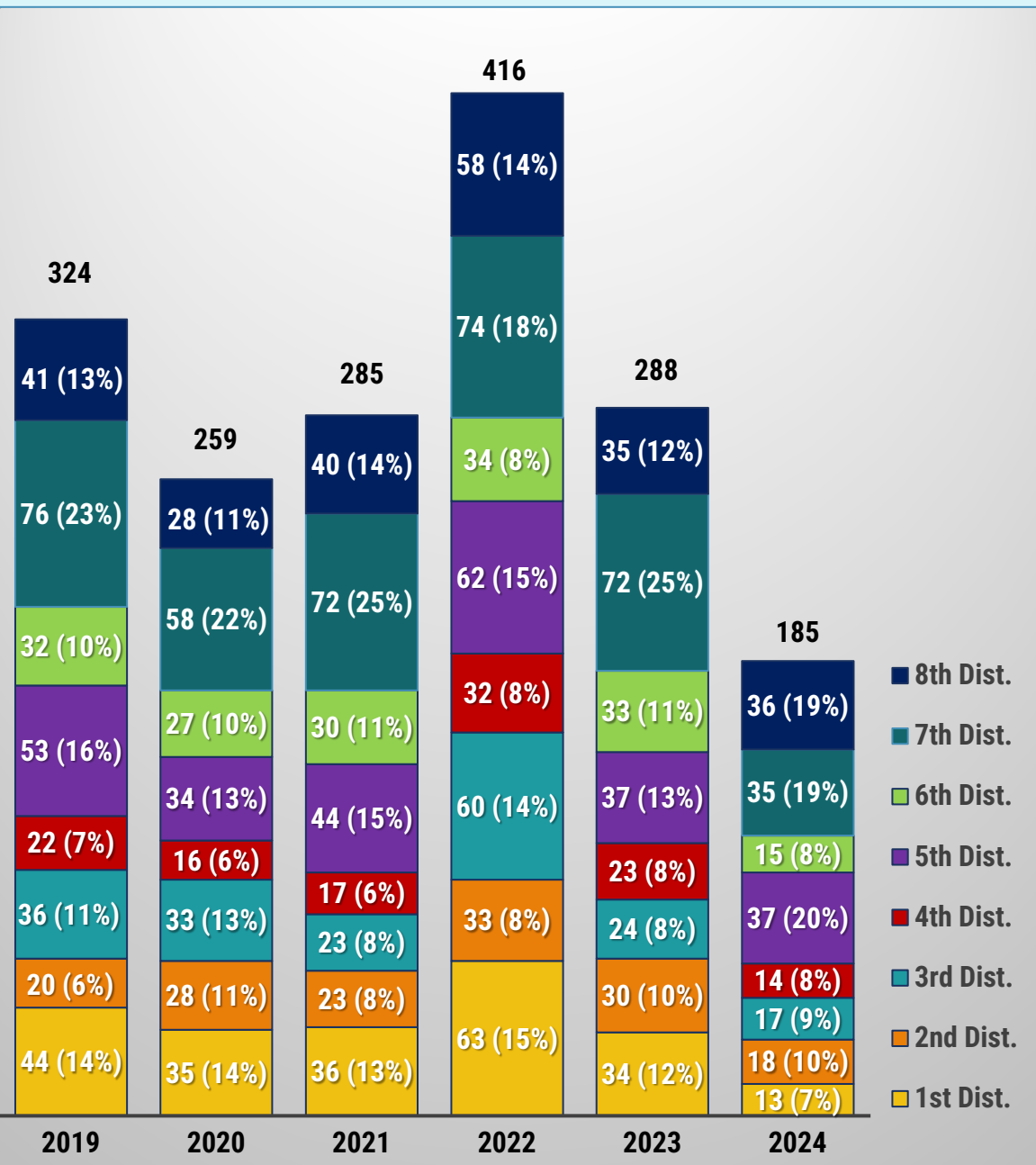

The 185 YTD armed robbery incidents is the fewest across the past six years. Citywide, armed robbery reached a YTD high of 416 in 2022 and declined **-56%** since then. Compared with 2023, YTD armed robbery declined **-36%**.

The **8th District** increased by one YTD armed robbery and the **5th District** had no change YTD 2023-2024.

All other NOPD Districts were at a 6-year low in YTD armed robbery in 2024.

The **1st District** showed the largest **(-62%)** decline. The **7th District (-51%)** had the largest raw number decline, from 72 YTD in 2023 to 35 YTD in 2024.

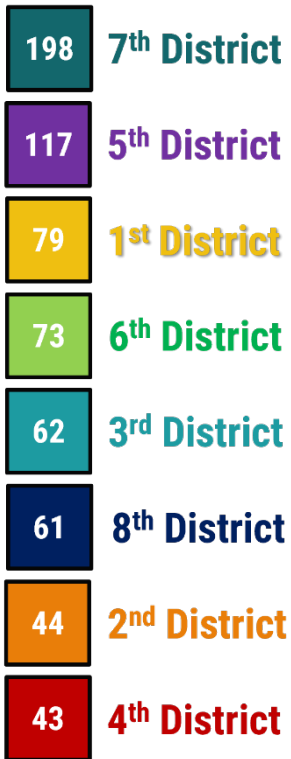


NOPD DISTRICT-LEVEL VIOLENT CRIME* AGGREGATE RANKINGS 2019-2024

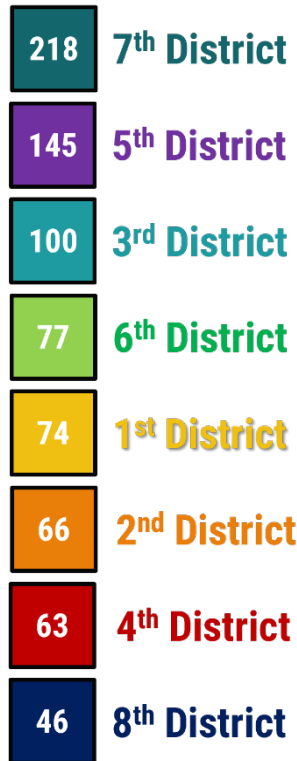

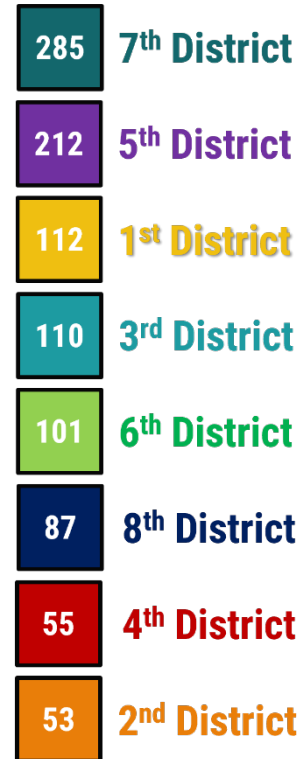
VIOLENT CRIME RANKINGS 2020

AS OF SEPTEMBER 30, 2020



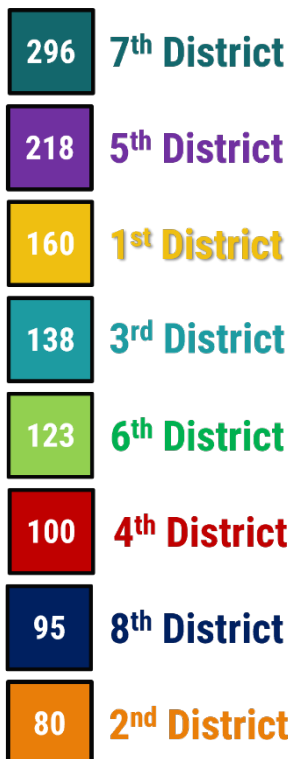

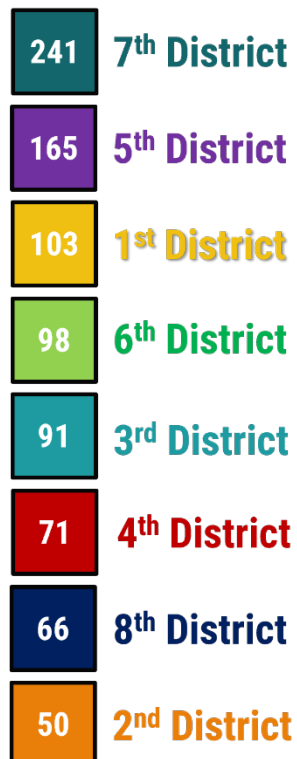
