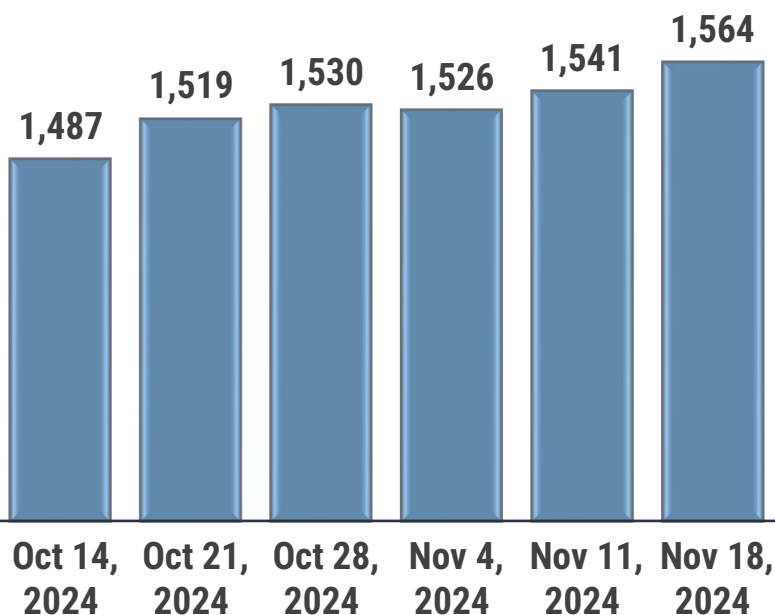




OPSO INMATE POPULATION SNAPSHOT

NOVEMBER 18, 2024

Inmates in Orleans Parish Sheriff's Office Custody – Six Week Trend



The inmate population continued to increase and is currently at its highest level since 2017.

Two-thirds (66%) were in custody for violent felony (59%) or weapons felony (7%) charges. The 235 in custody for homicide charges had been in custody an average of 633 days, nearly 2 years.

A total of 710 inmates or 45% of the inmate population had warrants, court holds, or probation/parole violations in addition to any other charges they were facing.

The 96 inmates with pending misdemeanor charges included 56 with violent charges and 36 with warrants or court holds.
