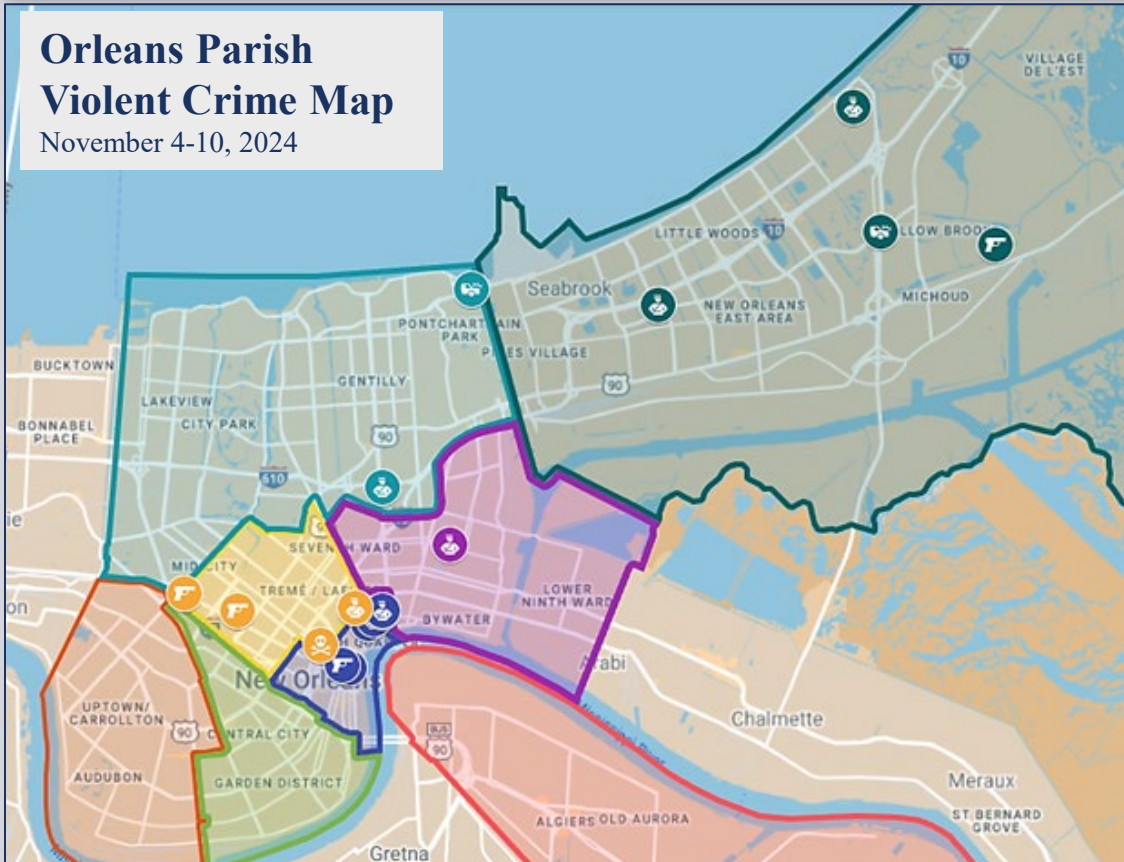


The 17 reported major violent incidents reported over the last week included 1 homicide, 5 nonfatal shootings, 2 carjackings, and 9 armed robberies.

Although there were no reported incidents in the 2nd, 4th, or 6th Districts, the 8th District reported six major violent crimes, and the 1st District reported four – the highest numbers in the city.

Homicide Victims: 120

- 40% since 2023 (201 victims)
- 50% since 2022 (239 victims)
- 31% since 2021 (173 victims)
- 21% since 2020 (152 victims)
- +25% since 2019 (96 victims)

Nonfatal Shooting Incidents: 192

- 42% since 2023 (329 incidents)
- 52% since 2022 (400 incidents)
- 55% since 2021 (422 incidents)
- 45% since 2020 (347 incidents)
- 9% since 2019 (211 incidents)

Carjacking Incidents: 78

- 40% since 2023 (130 incidents)
- 68% since 2022 (245 incidents)
- 64% since 2021 (219 incidents)
- 55% since 2020 (173 incidents)
- 11% since 2019 (88 incidents)

Armed Robbery Incidents: 214

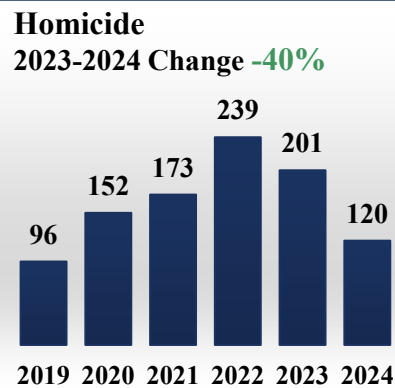
- 33% since 2023 (318 incidents)
- 56% since 2022 (482 incidents)
- 34% since 2021 (322 incidents)
- 34% since 2020 (324 incidents)
- 41% since 2019 (361 incidents)



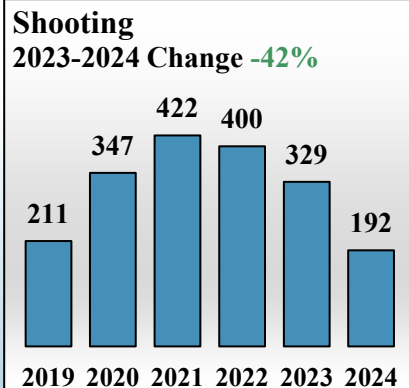

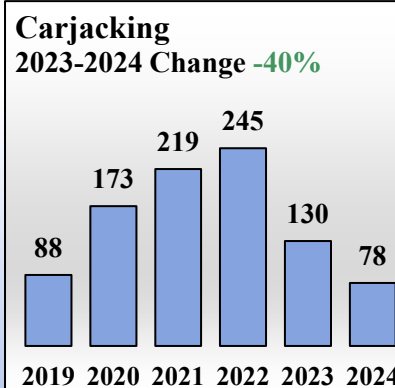

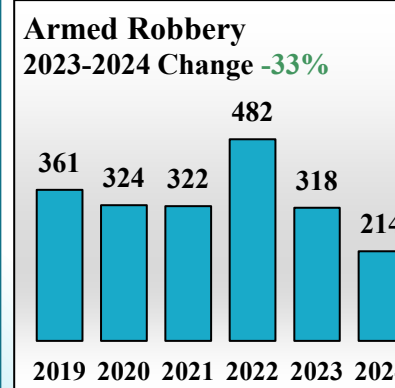

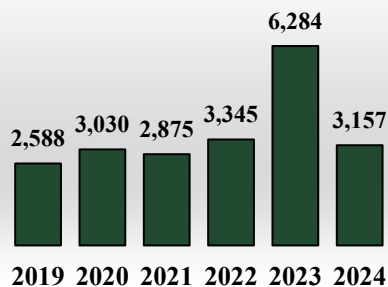

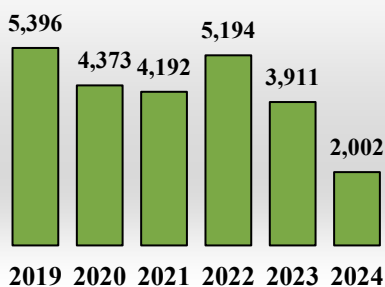

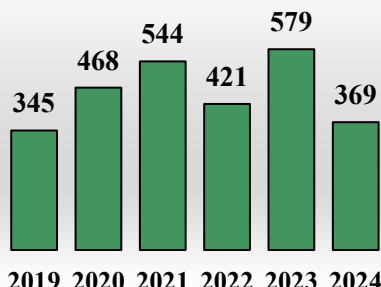

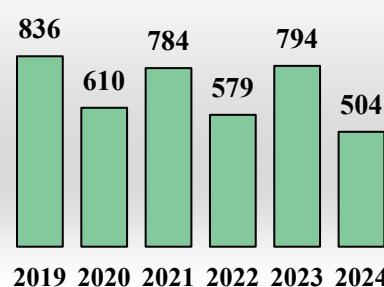

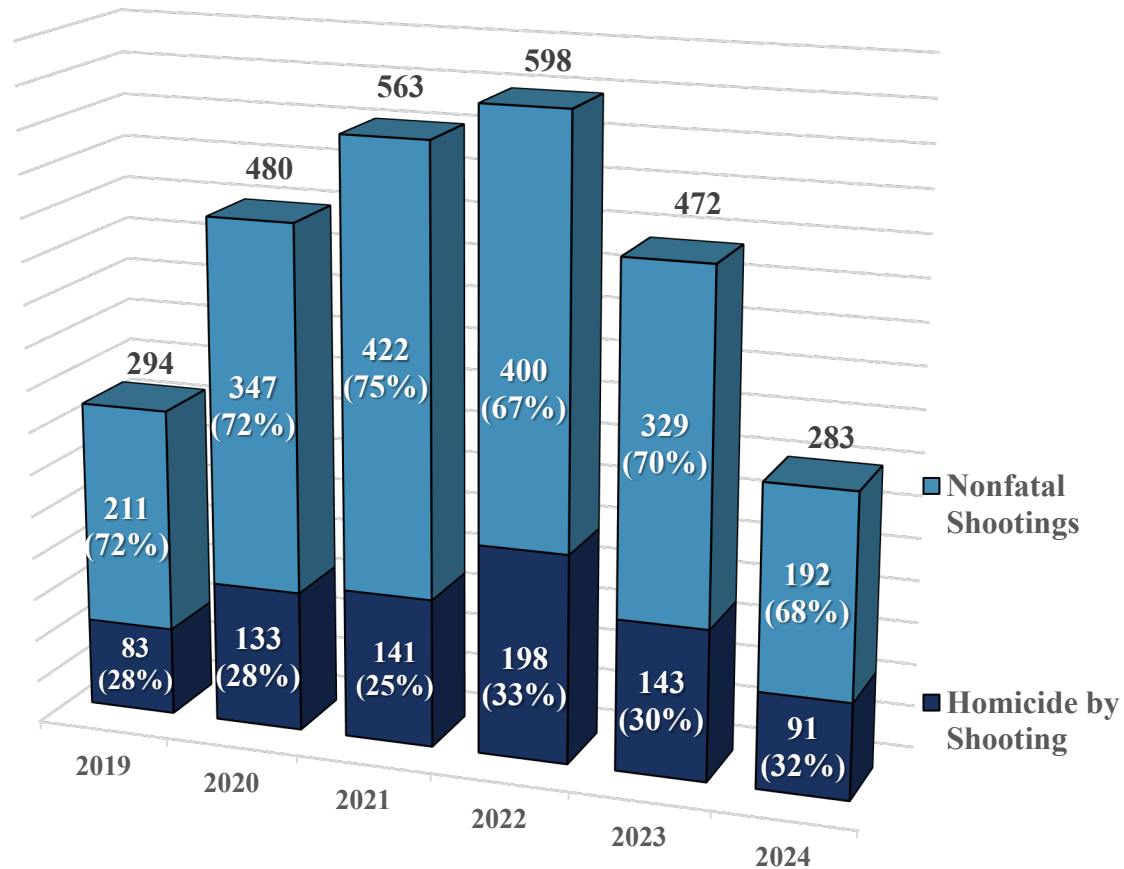

2023-2024 CHANGE: -40%

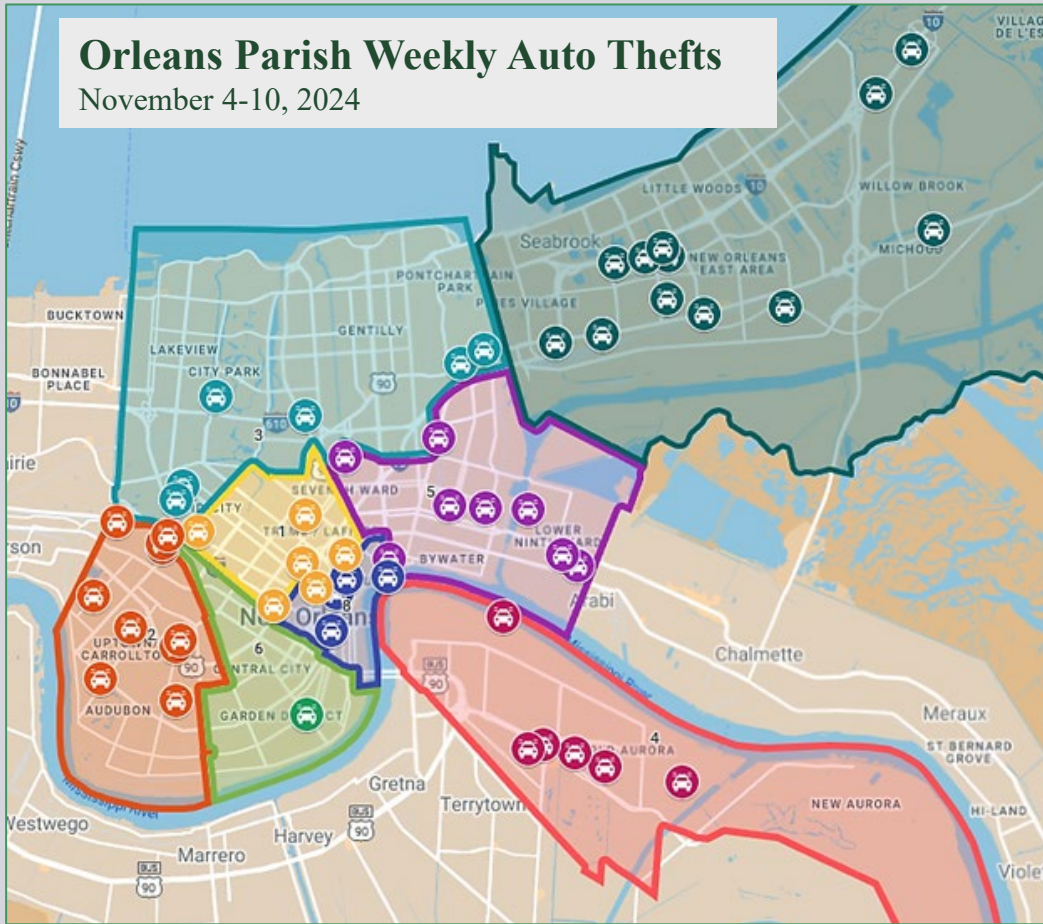

November 4-10, 2024



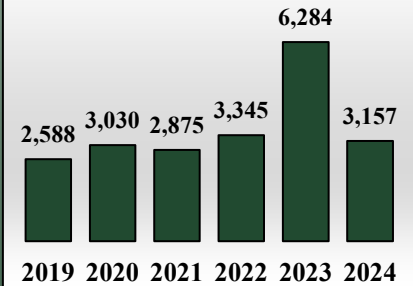
Between November 4-10, 2024, there were 54 reported auto thefts across Orleans Parish

2024	3,157	---
2023	6,284	-50%
2022	3,345	-6%

In 2024, there has been an average of 10 stolen vehicles per day.

This is a large improvement compared with 2023, when auto theft was occurring at a rate of 20 stolen vehicles per day.
