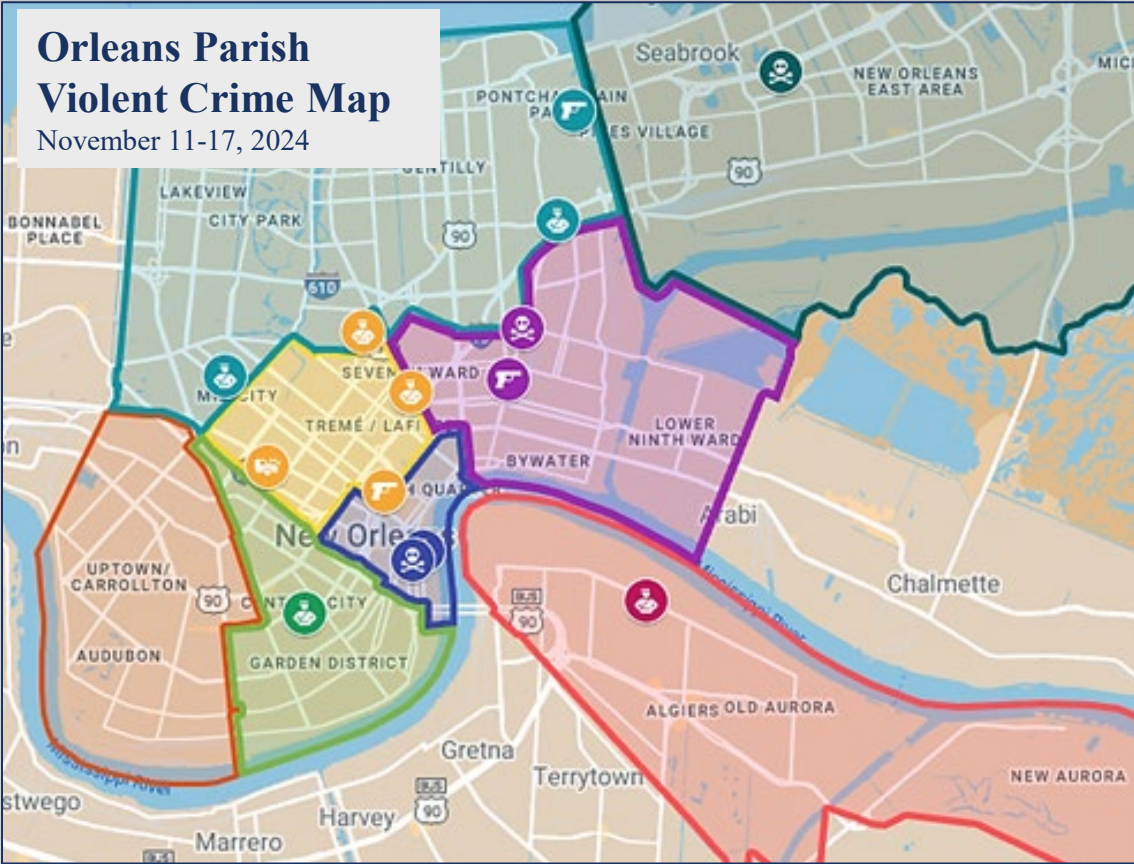


Last night's two mass shootings in the St. Roch neighborhood of the 5th District resulted in a total of 13 gunshot victims, two of them fatal.

There were two additional homicides by shooting, one in the 7th District and one in the 8th District, bringing the year-to-date homicide count to 124.

Homicide Victims: 124
 -39% since 2023 (204 victims)
 -49% since 2022 (243 victims)
 -30% since 2021 (177 victims)
 -20% since 2020 (155 victims)
 +27% since 2019 (98 victims)

Nonfatal Shooting Incidents: 195
 -42% since 2023 (334 incidents)
 -52% since 2022 (408 incidents)
 -55% since 2021 (430 incidents)
 -46% since 2020 (359 incidents)
 -8% since 2019 (213 incidents)



Carjacking Incidents: 79
 -39% since 2023 (130 incidents)
 -68% since 2022 (249 incidents)
 -66% since 2021 (230 incidents)
 -57% since 2020 (183 incidents)
 -10% since 2019 (88 incidents)

Armed Robbery Incidents: 221
 -32% since 2023 (325 incidents)
 -55% since 2022 (487 incidents)
 -34% since 2021 (335 incidents)
 -34% since 2020 (335 incidents)
 -40% since 2019 (371 incidents)



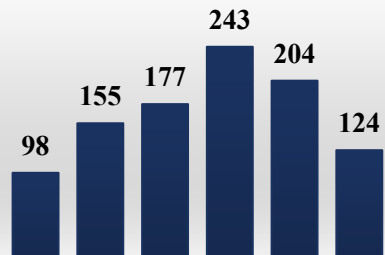

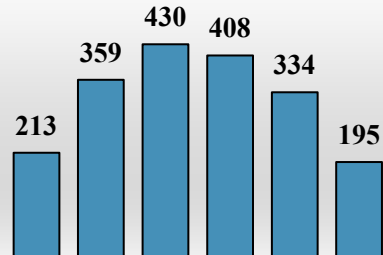

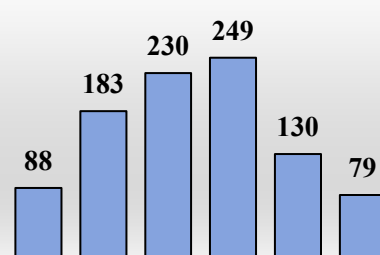

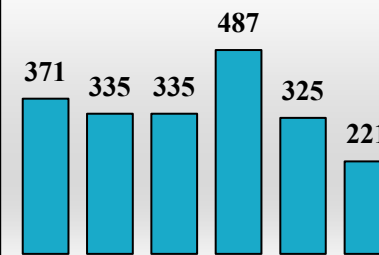

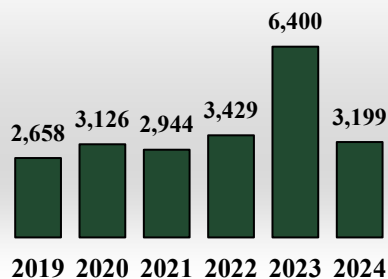

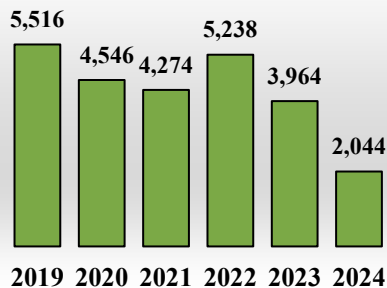

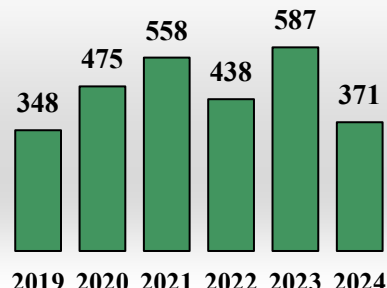

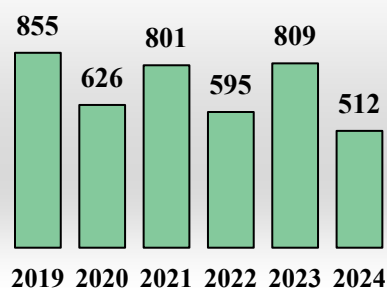

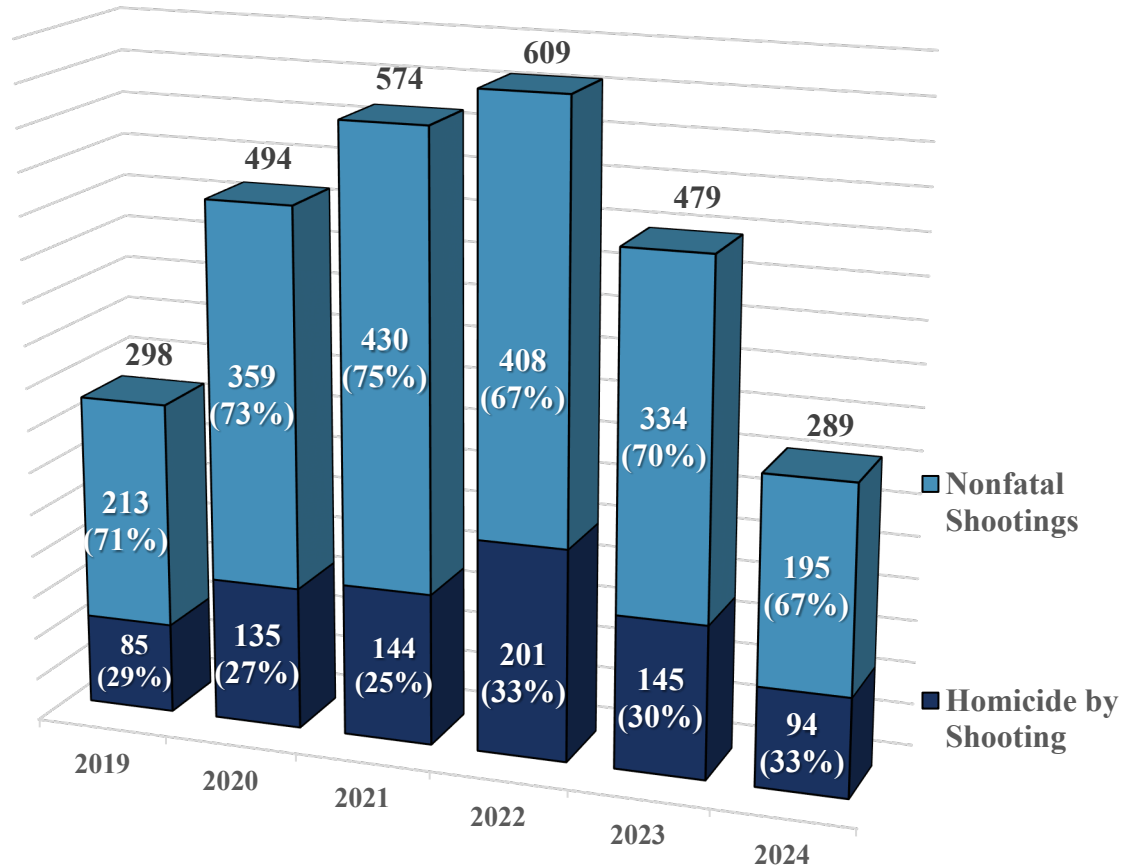

2023-2024 CHANGE: -40%

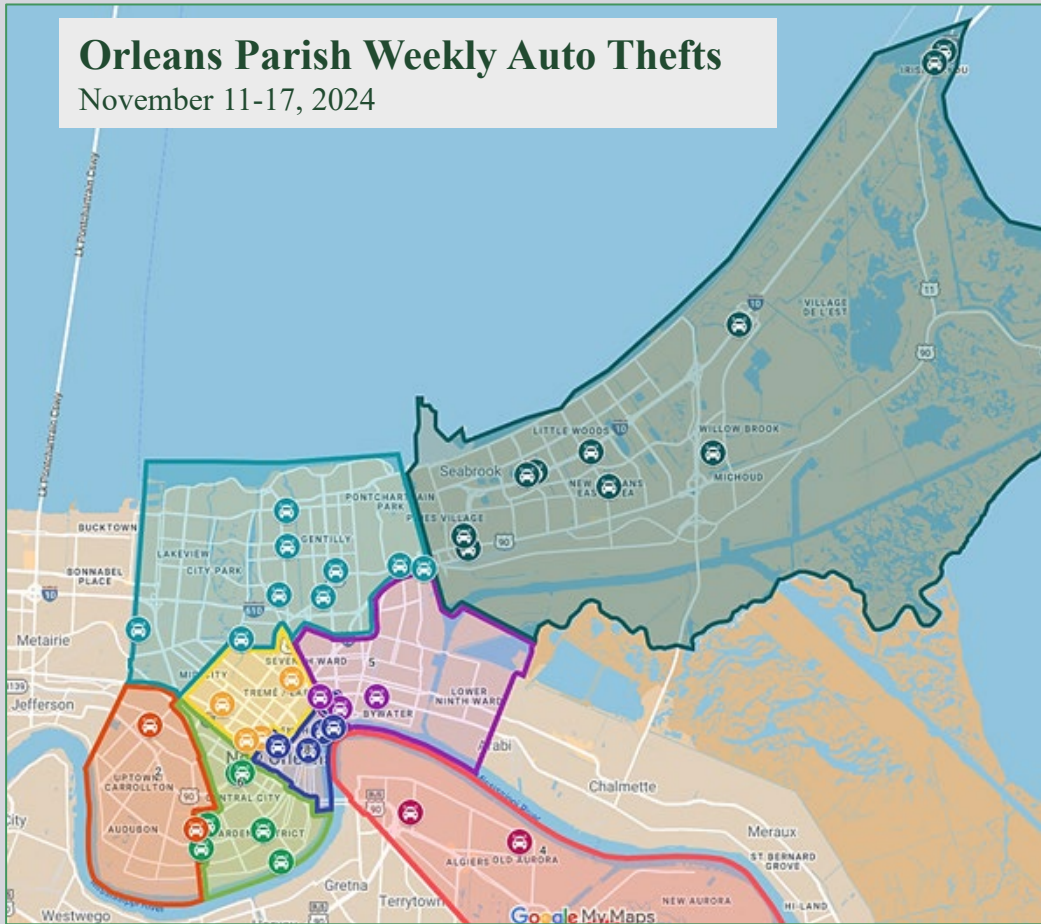

November 11-17, 2024

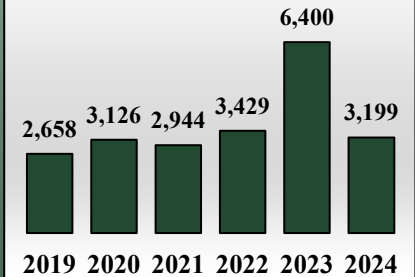


Between November 11-17, 2024, there were 42 reported auto thefts across Orleans Parish

- 6th District: 6 auto theft**
- 7th District: 10 auto thefts**
- 8th District: 6 auto thefts**

Auto Theft 2023-2024 Change -50%



Year	Reported Auto Theft	2024 Change
2024	3,199	---
2023	6,400	-50%
2022	3,429	-7%
2021	2,944	+9%
2020	3,126	+2%
2019	2,658	+20%

In 2024, there has been an average of 10 stolen vehicles per day.

This is a large improvement compared with 2023, when auto theft was occurring at a rate of 20 stolen vehicles per day.
