



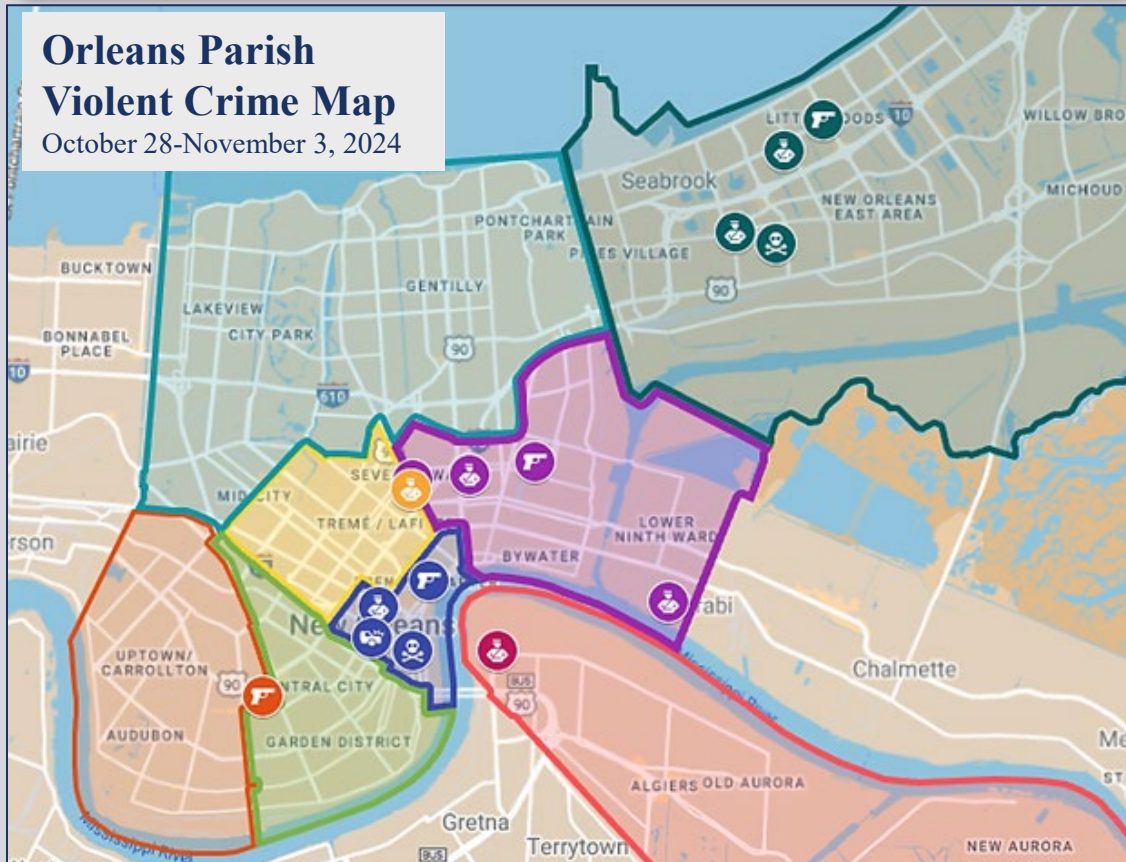
ORLEANS PARISH CRIME TRENDS

AS OF NOVEMBER 3, 2019-2024

Fifteen violent incidents last week included a double homicide in the 7th District and a fatal drive-by shooting in the 8th District, as well as 5 nonfatal shootings, 1 carjacking, and 7 armed robberies. There were no incidents reported in the 3rd District or 6th District.

Homicide Victims: 118

- 39% since 2023 (194 victims)
- 50% since 2022 (236 victims)
- 31% since 2021 (170 victims)
- 21% since 2020 (149 victims)
- +24% since 2019 (95 victims)

Nonfatal Shooting Incidents: 188

- 42% since 2023 (323 incidents)
- 52% since 2022 (388 incidents)
- 55% since 2021 (416 incidents)
- 44% since 2020 (336 incidents)
- 10% since 2019 (209 incidents)

Carjacking Incidents: 76

- 41% since 2023 (128 incidents)
- 69% since 2022 (245 incidents)
- 65% since 2021 (217 incidents)
- 54% since 2020 (167 incidents)
- 12% since 2019 (86 incidents)

Armed Robbery Incidents: 205

- 35% since 2023 (313 incidents)
- 55% since 2022 (458 incidents)
- 36% since 2021 (319 incidents)
- 35% since 2020 (315 incidents)
- 42% since 2019 (354 incidents)



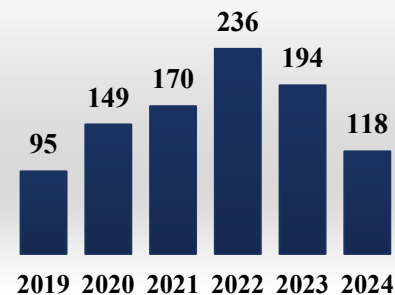

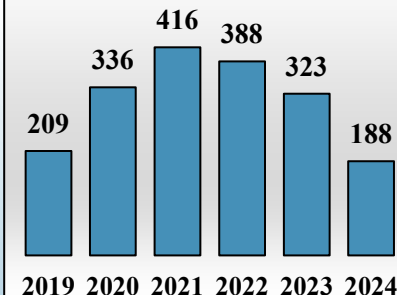

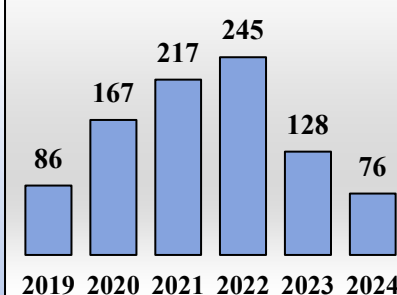

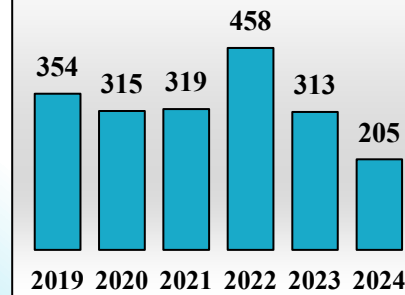

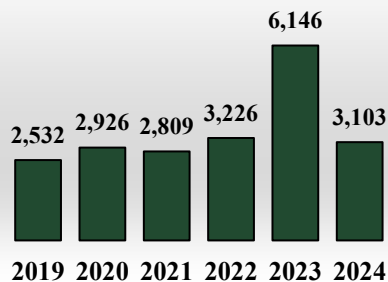

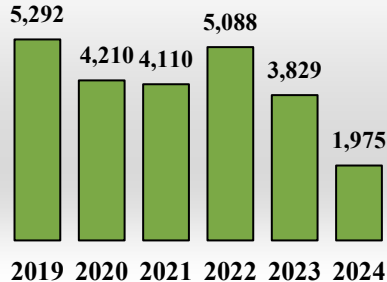

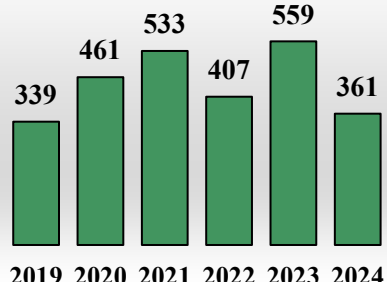

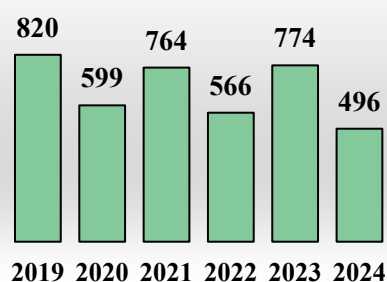

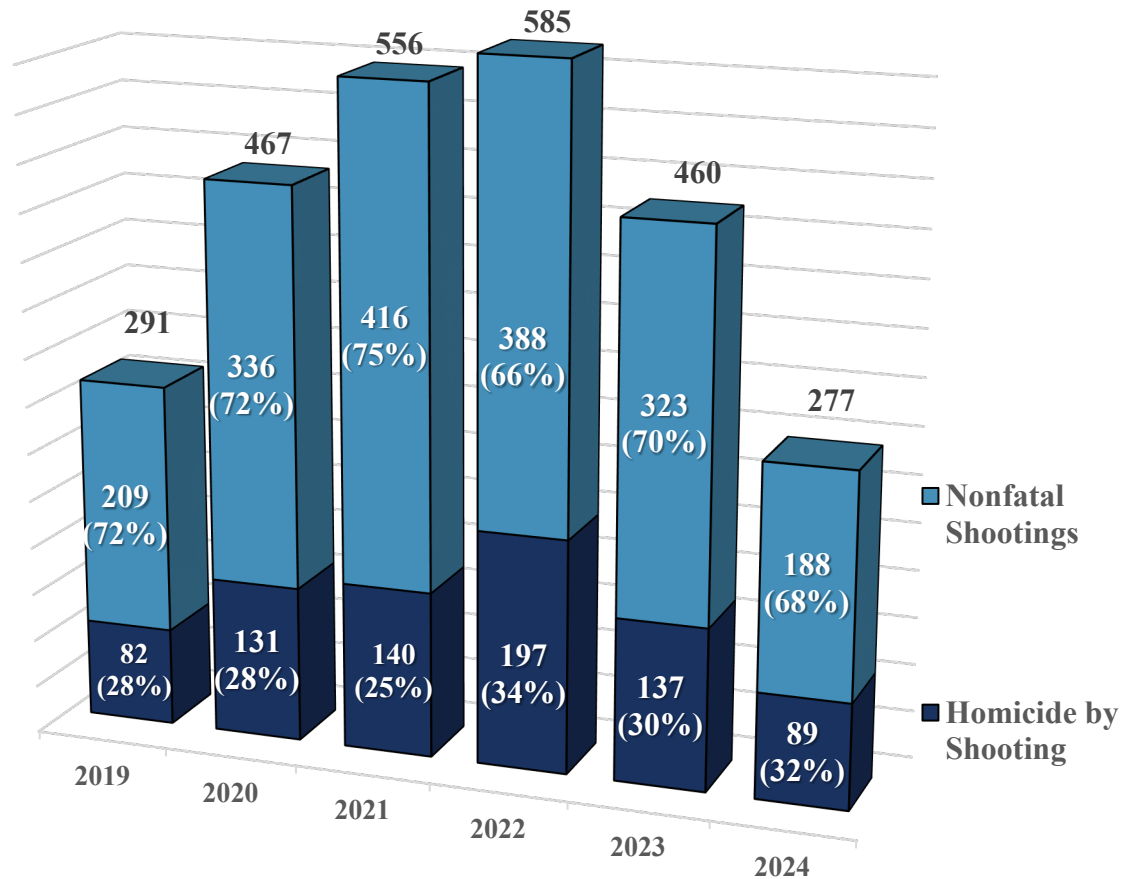

2023-2024 CHANGE: -40%

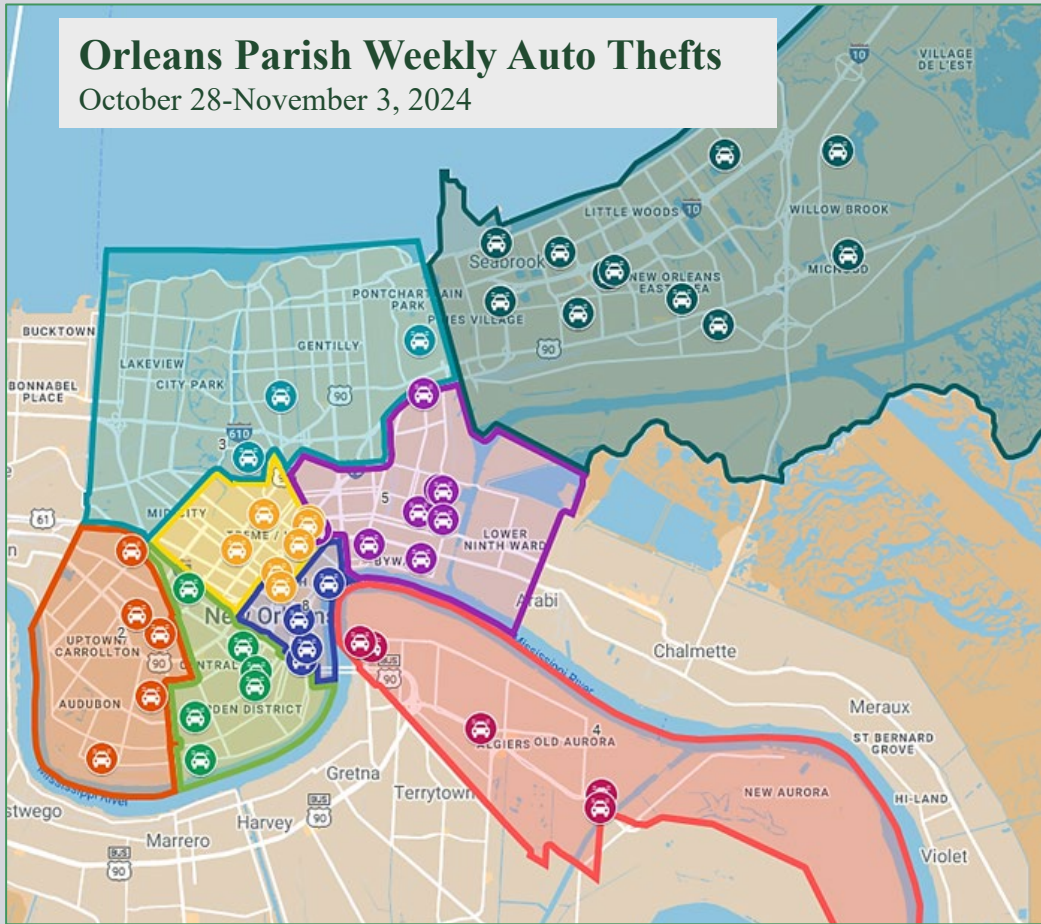

October 28-November 3, 2024

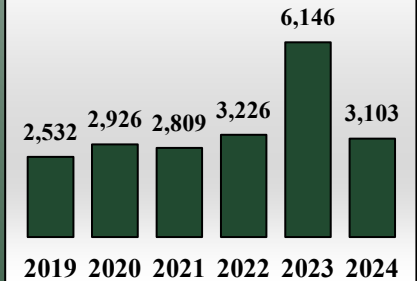


Between October 28-November 3, 2024, there were **64 reported auto thefts across Orleans Parish**

- 1st District: 12 auto thefts**
- 2nd District: 2 auto thefts**
- 3rd District: 7 auto thefts**
- 4th District: 4 auto thefts**
- 5th District: 9 auto thefts**
- 6th District: 6 auto thefts**
- 7th District: 10 auto thefts**
- 8th District: 14 auto thefts**

Auto Theft 2023-2024 Change -50%



Year	Reported Auto Theft	2024 Change
2024	3,103	---
2023	6,146	-50%
2022	3,226	-4%
2021	2,809	+10%

2019	2,532	+23%

In 2024, there has been an average of 10 stolen vehicles per day.

This is a large improvement compared with 2023, when auto theft was occurring at a rate of 20 stolen vehicles per day.
