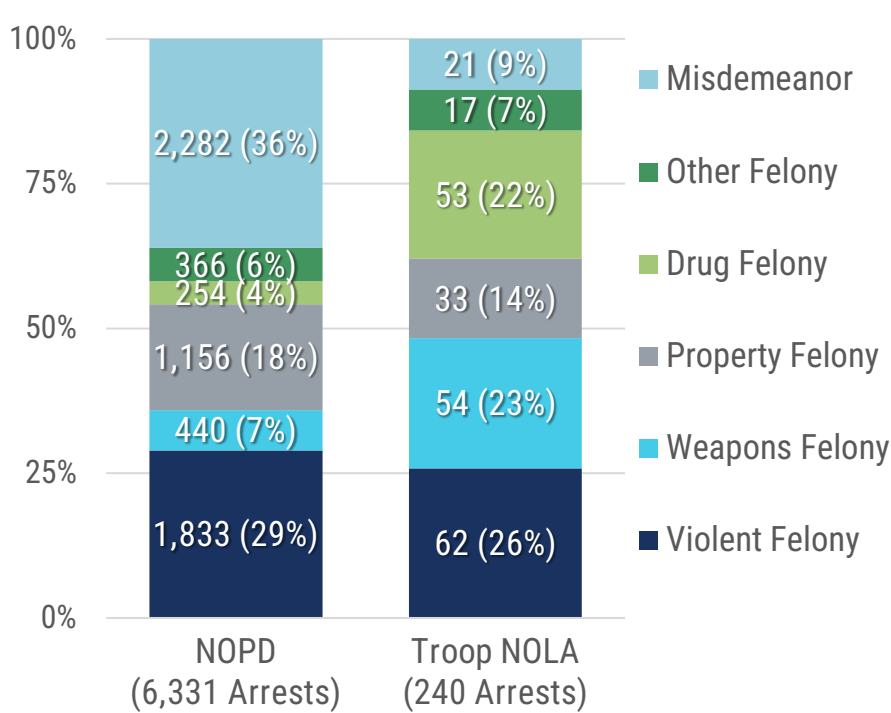




TROOP NOLA ARRESTS & PROSECUTIONS JANUARY-OCTOBER 2024

Most Serious Arrest Charges by Arresting Agency



The Louisiana State Police Troop NOLA made 240 state arrests January-October 2024.

- 62 or 26% for violent felonies
- 54 or 23% for weapons felonies
- 53 or 22% for drug felonies, including 39 for drug distribution
- 31 of 33 Troop NOLA arrests for property felonies were for theft, typically a stolen car

Only 9% of Troop NOLA arrests were for misdemeanor charges, compared to 36% of NOPD arrests for misdemeanors.

- Over half (54%) of NOPD misdemeanor arrests were for battery or domestic violence, which result from responding to calls for service

87% of Troop NOLA cases screened by the La. AG's Office were accepted as felonies.

Two (2) misdemeanor arrests were upgraded to felonies.

5% were felony arrests downgraded to misdemeanor prosecutions.

The AG's 2 refused cases were for possession of a stolen automobile.

The AG was still reviewing approximately 50 Troop NOLA arrests to reach a decision.

The average screening time was 39 days, and none of the Troop NOLA arrests resulted in a 701 release.

The remaining arrests were cases prosecuted in another parish or by the Orleans DA. When Troop NOLA arrests someone with a warrant based on an NOPD investigation, the Orleans DA handles the prosecution.
