

# NOPD DISTRICT-LEVEL VIOLENT CRIME TRENDS


Aggregate citywide incidents of homicide, nonfatal shooting, carjacking, and armed robbery declined **-36%** from 2023-2024.

Since reaching a high watermark of 1,575 incidents in 2022, major violent crime declined **-55%** to 704 reported incidents in 2024.

The **1<sup>st</sup> District (-55%)** and **7<sup>th</sup> District (-47%)** had the highest rates of decline in overall violent crime.

The **7<sup>th</sup> District** had the largest raw number decline of the 8 NOPD Districts, dropping from 297 reported violent incidents in 2023 to 157 in 2024.

The **8<sup>th</sup> District** increased **+5%**, from 84 reported incidents in 2023 to 88 in 2024.

Citywide, homicide declined **-35%** from 2023-2024 and **-49%** from 2022-2024.

The **1<sup>st</sup> District** showed the largest **(-75%)** reduction, from 32 in 2023, to 8 in 2024. Other notable declines since 2023 included the **4<sup>th</sup> District (-54%)**, and the **7<sup>th</sup> District (-44%)**.

The **7<sup>th</sup> District** had the largest raw number decline, from 70 in 2023 to 39 in 2024.

The **2<sup>nd</sup> District** increased **+22%** from 9 homicides in 2023 to 11 in 2024.

The **+88%** increase in **8<sup>th</sup> District** homicide reflects an increase from 8 in 2023 to 15 in 2024.




Citywide nonfatal shooting incidents reached a six-year low in 2024, declining -42% since 2023, -55% since 2022, and -56% since 2021.

The 1<sup>st</sup> District has shown the largest (-60%) reduction in nonfatal shooting, from 43 incidents in 2023, to 17 in 2024. The 1<sup>st</sup> District also had the largest reduction in homicide.

The 7<sup>th</sup> District showed a notable (-52%) decline, with 56 fewer shooting incidents reported in 2024 than in 2023.

Nonfatal shooting is the only violent crime category to show declines across all 8 NOPD Districts compared with 2023.






Citywide carjacking incidents reached an annual high of 288 in 2021. At 90 in 2024, carjacking declined -39% since 2023, -68% since 2022, and -69% since 2021.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> District showed the largest carjacking decline (-77%), from 35 in 2023 to 8 in 2024.

Several other districts showed notable decline in carjacking, including the 6<sup>th</sup> District (-67%), 4<sup>th</sup> District (-50%), and 7<sup>th</sup> District (-42%).

The 1<sup>st</sup> District increased +45% since 2023, from 11 to 16 carjacking incidents reported in 2024. The 2<sup>nd</sup> District increased by 1 carjacking incident.



# NOPD DISTRICT-LEVEL ARMED ROBBERY TRENDS

The 255 reported armed robbery incidents is the fewest across the past six years. Citywide, armed robbery reached a high of 541 in 2022 and declined -53% since then. Since 2023, armed robbery declined -30%.

The 8<sup>th</sup> District had the highest number of reported armed robberies (49) and was the only NOPD District to show increase (+20%) from 2023-2024.

All other NOPD Districts were at a 6-year low in YTD armed robbery in 2024.

The 1<sup>st</sup> District showed the largest (-61%) decline. The 7<sup>th</sup> District (-45%) had the largest raw number decline, from 87 in 2023 to 48 in 2024.

**Overall, aggregate 1<sup>st</sup> District violent crime declined -55% from 2023-2024, the largest reduction of any NOPD District.**

The 1<sup>st</sup> District had the largest declines in **homicide (-75%)** and **nonfatal shooting (-60%)** of any NOPD District from 2023 to 2024.

In 2023, the 1<sup>st</sup> District had the third highest number of all NOPD Districts of both **homicide** and **nonfatal shooting**. In 2024, the 1<sup>st</sup> District ranked 7 of 8 NOPD Districts on both categories.

Although the 1<sup>st</sup> District had an increase **(+45%)** in **carjacking** between 2023-2024, there has been a substantial **(-63%)** decline in 1<sup>st</sup> District **carjacking** since 2022.

1<sup>st</sup> District **armed robbery** was at a six-year low in 2024 and has declined **-78%** since reaching a high of 90 in 2022.

The 2<sup>nd</sup> District declined **-21%** on aggregate violent crime from 2023-2024.

At 11 **homicides**, the 2<sup>nd</sup> District ranked 6 of the 8 NOPD Districts on **homicide** in 2024.

2<sup>nd</sup> District **nonfatal shooting** incidents decreased **-9%**, from 11 in 2023 to 10 in 2024. The 2<sup>nd</sup> District has had fewer **nonfatal shooting** incidents than any other NOPD District in 2024.

2<sup>nd</sup> District **carjacking** reached a high of 25 in 2022 and has since declined **-64%**. The 2<sup>nd</sup> District increased by one **carjacking** from 2023 and 2024.

2<sup>nd</sup> District **armed robbery** was at a 6-year low in 2024.. The 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Districts each ranked seventh of the 8 NOPD Districts in **armed robbery**.





From 2023-2024, the 3<sup>rd</sup> District declined **-40%** in aggregate major violent crime incidents.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> District declined **-28%** on **homicide**, dropping from 18 in 2023 to 13 in 2024.

3<sup>rd</sup> District **nonfatal shooting** reached a high of 59 in 2022 and has since declined **-68%**. At 19 **nonfatal shootings** in 2024, the 3<sup>rd</sup> District declined **-24%** since 2023.

The 3<sup>rd</sup> District had the largest reduction (**-77%**) in **carjacking** from 2023 to 2024. Since reaching a high of 47 **carjackings** in 2021, the 3<sup>rd</sup> District has declined **-83%**.

3<sup>rd</sup> District **armed robbery** has declined **-67%** since 2022 and **-17%** since 2023. At 25 **armed robberies**, the 3<sup>rd</sup> District ranked fourth of the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024.






The 4<sup>th</sup> District declined **-36%** overall in aggregate violent crime between 2023-2024, matching the citywide decline.

At 6 **homicides** in 2024, the 4<sup>th</sup> District had the lowest **homicide** rate of the 8 NOPD Districts. 4<sup>th</sup> District **homicide** declined **-75%** since 2022 and **-54%** since 2023.

4<sup>th</sup> District **nonfatal shooting** declined **-46%** since 2022 and **-19%** since 2023. At 21 incidents in 2024, the 4<sup>th</sup> District ranked fourth of the 8 NOPD Districts in **nonfatal shooting**.

**Carjacking** in the 4<sup>th</sup> District reached a high of 24 in 2022 and declined to 9 (**-63%**) in 2024. Compared with 2023, 4<sup>th</sup> District **carjacking** declined **-50%**.

Since reaching a high of 41 **armed robberies** in 2022, the 4<sup>th</sup> District declined **-44%** in 2024. From 2023-2024, 4<sup>th</sup> District **armed robbery** declined **-34%**.





From 2023-2024, the 5<sup>th</sup> District declined **-27%** in overall violent crime. This is the only NOPD District that saw the highest rates of aggregate violent crime in 2021.

5<sup>th</sup> District **homicide** declined **-30%** since 2023 and **-42%** since reaching a 6-year high of 55 **homicides** in 2021.

Despite a **-40%** decline in **nonfatal shooting**, the 5<sup>th</sup> District ranked first of the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024, with 52 reported incidents.

Since 2022, 5<sup>th</sup> District **carjacking** declined **-55%**, from 42 to 19 incidents and **-14%** since 2023, from 22 to 19.

Since 2022, 5<sup>th</sup> District **armed robbery** declined **-43%**, from 76 to 43 in 2024. Since 2023, **armed robbery** in the 5<sup>th</sup> District dropped only **-7%**, from 46 to 43.





6<sup>th</sup> District **homicide** declined **-38%** from 2022 to 2024 and **-17%** from 2023 to 2024.

**Nonfatal shooting** in the 6<sup>th</sup> District has declined **-56%** since reaching a high of 59 in 2021.

At 20 **homicides** and 26 **nonfatal shootings**, the 6<sup>th</sup> District ranked third highest of the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024.

**Carjacking** in the 6<sup>th</sup> District declined **-84%** since reaching a high of 32 in 2022. Since 2023, **carjacking** declined **-67%** in the 6<sup>th</sup> District, which was tied with the 8<sup>th</sup> District for lowest number of incidents across the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024.

**Armed robbery** in the 6<sup>th</sup> District was at a six-year low of 24 in 2024. Since 2023, 6<sup>th</sup> District **armed robbery** declined **-33%**.





Overall, the 7<sup>th</sup> District had the largest raw number decline (-140 incidents) in aggregate violent crime across the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024.

While still ranked first of 8 NOPD Districts for having the highest number of **homicides** in 2024, the 7<sup>th</sup> District declined -44% since 2023 and -55% since 2022.

**Nonfatal shooting** declined -62% since reaching a high of 97 incidents in 2020. Since 2023, 7<sup>th</sup> District **nonfatal shooting** declined -52% to a six-year low of 51 incidents in 2024.

**Carjacking** in the 7<sup>th</sup> District has declined substantially (-80%) since reaching a high of 93 incidents in 2021. Since 2023, 7<sup>th</sup> District **carjacking** declined -42%.

**Armed robbery** in the 7<sup>th</sup> District declined -45% in 2024 compared to 2023. The 7<sup>th</sup> District second highest number of **armed robberies** of the 8 NOPD Districts in 2024.






The 8<sup>th</sup> District is the only NOPD District with an overall increase in violent crime (+5%) since 2023.

8<sup>th</sup> District **homicide** reached a six-year high in 2024. At 15 **homicides**, the 8<sup>th</sup> District ranked 4 of the 8 NOPD Districts.

**Nonfatal shooting** in the 8<sup>th</sup> District declined -42% since reaching a high of 33 in 2021. 8<sup>th</sup> District **nonfatal shooting** declined -34% from 2023 to 2024.

8<sup>th</sup> District **carjacking** declined -69% since 2022 and -17% since 2023. **Carjacking** is the only category of crime in the 8<sup>th</sup> District to show declines compared with all past 5 years.

8<sup>th</sup> District **armed robbery** is -26% lower in 2024 compared with 2022. However, at 49 incidents, the 8<sup>th</sup> District increased +20% from 2023-2024.






