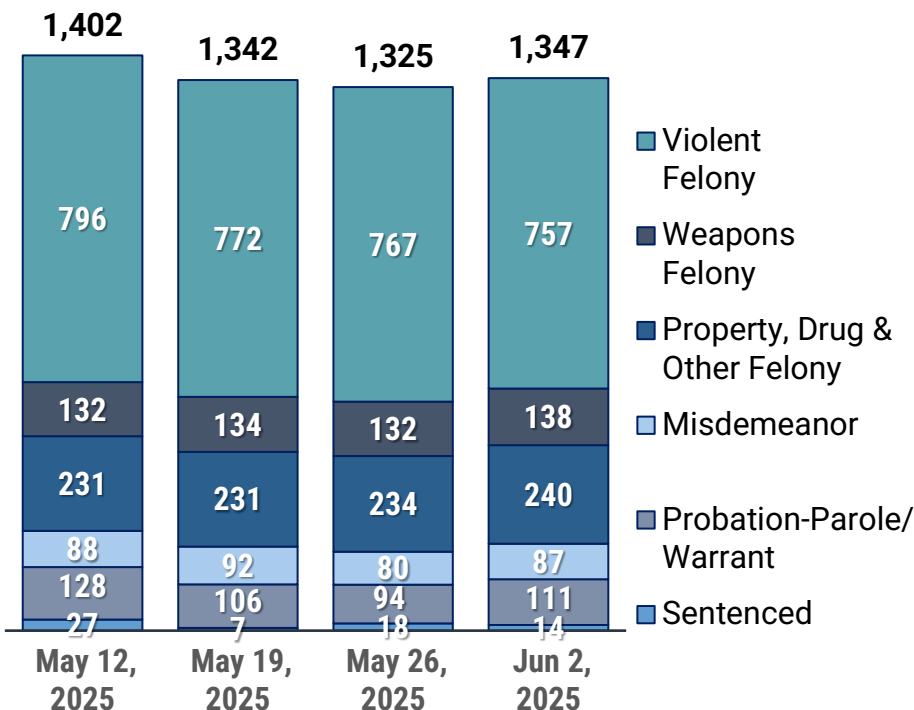




# OPSO INMATE POPULATION SNAPSHOT

## JUNE 2, 2025

### Inmates in Orleans Parish Sheriff's Office Custody – Four Week Trend



The inmate population rose by 22 up to 1,347 on June 2, 2025.

More than 90% of inmates were held for felony charges.

As of June 2, 2025, two of the 10 inmates who escaped custody on May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2025, remained at large.

The largest segment of the population was 757 inmates (56%) held for violent felony charges. They had spent an average of 374 days or just over 1 year in OPSO custody.

The most common charge holding inmates in custody was homicide. There were 212 inmates charged with homicide who averaged 678 days or over 22 months in custody. Inmates charged with homicide included 15 charged with first degree murder, 193 charged with second degree murder, and 4 charged with manslaughter.

The 128 female inmates accounted for 10% of the total inmate population on June 2, 2025. Female inmates were an average of 35 years old, ranging from ages 17 to 70. They had spent an average of 176 days or just under 6 months in custody.

Charges against female inmates included 20 for felony battery/assault, (16%), 14 for homicide (11%), and 11 for robbery (9%).

The number of inmates held for probation/parole holds or warrants increased from 95 on May 26<sup>th</sup>, 2025, to 111 on June 2, 2025.

Sentenced inmates who did not have actively pending charges decreased from 17 on May 26, 2025, to 14 on June 2, 2025.

Generally, the OPSO has limited ability to reduce the inmate population. Aside from the time it takes to process inmates cleared for release, inmates are held in custody while awaiting screening decisions from prosecutors or for their charges to be resolved under a judge's case management.

**Methodology:** The MCC received a list of OPSO inmates and charges that were filed against them. Inmates were categorized by the most serious actively pending charge holding them in custody.
